Public notice of changes to The Procter & Gamble Paper Products Company's Industrial Pretreatment Wastewater Discharge Permit by Brigham City Corporation.

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to solicit public comment regarding modifications to the The Procter & Gamble Paper Products Company's Industrial Pretreatment Wastewater Discharge Permit by Brigham City Corporation. This change is considered a substantial modification of Brigham City Wastewater Treatment Plant's Pretreatment Program as limits are being applied for Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) and total chlorides without an approved local limit for these. Once the 30-day public notice period and comment process are completed it is the intent of Brigham City to issue the permit including these limits.

BACKGROUND

Brigham City Corporation has modified Procter & Gamble's Industrial Pretreatment Wastewater Discharge Permit to include limits on Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) and total Chlorides. This is being done to ensure that Brigham City will not violate the water quality standard for TDS in the wastewater that is discharged to Box Elder Creek. As Brigham City does not currently have a Local Limit for these pollutants public comment is solicited for these new limits only.

A public hearing can be requested although must be filed during the comment period which will end on **August 27, 2021**. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirements of 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the director may approve, revise or abandon the revisions to the permit. Brigham City will not publish a notice of decision provided the permit is approved without any changes and no comments are received during the public comment period.
