

EAGLE RISE HIKING/BIKING TRAIL

In 2010, Mayor Dennis Fife organized the Brigham City Bicycle Committee with a goal of making Brigham City bicycle friendly and a safer place to ride.

Committee members Jack Leavitt, Gary Dixon, Jen Packer, Holly Patterson, David Harrison, Scott Lyons, Deborah Adams and Paul Larsen worked to have bike lanes installed on some City streets and signage added to increase awareness. Project funding was possible with a grant from Box Elder County Tourism.

Eagle Rise Trail, appropriately named after the Eagle Scouts, continues to grow with the majority of volunteer efforts coming from Eagle Scout projects and additional efforts coming from volunteers throughout the community. Eagle Rise consists of four loops, each approximately two miles long. Five of the seven benches along the trail were donated by local businesses. The two remaining benches were donated and installed by the Box Elder Composite Mountain Bike Team, who use the trails for training.
