

RESOLUTION NO. 20-37

WHEREAS, the Brigham City Council deems it necessary and desirable to charge certain fees for use of City, Courses, Courts, and Sport Fields; and

WHEREAS, the fees collected shall be budgeted for expense each year for the purpose of making improvements to the sporting fields and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Brigham City Council has determined that these fees should be adopted by Resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRIGHAM CITY, UTAH with 5 members present and 5 voting in favor thereof, that the following fees be adopted, and that all said fees continue to be budgeted for expense for improvements to the areas for which they are paid and the adoption of the following user groups and guidelines.

Pickleball

Single Court Rental: \$10 per court per hour (exclusive use)

Blocks of Courts*	4 Hour Block	Per Day (6am-10pm)
4 Courts	\$80.00	\$240.00
8 Courts	\$160.00	\$480.00
12 Courts	\$240.00	\$720.00
17 Courts**	\$320.00	\$960.00****
24 Courts***	\$400.00	\$1,200.00****

* An additional Special Event permit may be required based upon event parameters

**** \$500 deposit is required to reserve the venue one year in advance max, unless approved by the Special Event Committee. Remaining total of venue fees are due 45 calendar days prior to the event. Cancellations require a 90-day notice, under 90 days forfeits deposit.

The Brigham City reserves the right to schedule activities and events on City courses, courts and sport fields on an "as available" basis. The following priority applies to all scheduling:

Two Courts \$20.00 per hour
Four Courts \$40.00 per hour

Wadman Courts

Court Use \$10.00 per hour

Disc Golf Course

Tournament Fee \$40.00
Weekly Leagues \$15.00 per week

Sports Complex

All users, including Box Elder School District \$20.00 1st use/single game
\$15.00 each additional game
\$20.00 per game lights

All Other Fields

Community-Based Organizations (volunteer operated), including, but not limited to:

- AYSO (includes league and Golden Spike Tournament)
- WFFL (includes league and Thanksgiving Tournament)
- Box Elder Junior Lacrosse

\$5.00 per participant, per season

Competitive, Accelerated, High School Club Teams or Super Leagues

\$15 1st use/single game
\$10 each additional game, same day use
\$20 game lights, if available

Adult Programs, including, but not limited to:

Baseball, Softball, Soccer, Football

\$15 1st use/single game
\$10 each additional game
\$20 per game lights

\$10 reserved practice time
(for Non-Brigham City Users)

Private Program Providers

\$15 1st use/single game
\$10.00 each additional game
\$20 per game lights

1. Brigham City Community Activities and Services Programming (CAS)
2. Box Elder School District sport teams Monday-Friday use. Any weekend use would be subject to a fee schedule.
3. All others on a first come, first served basis

Guidelines

1. Brigham City reserves the right to cancel any scheduled activity due to conditions or circumstances that are determined to be detrimental, unsafe or in conflict with City ordinances or resolutions.
2. The courses, courts and sport fields use fees will be paid in advance of use and before the event is scheduled on the calendar. The Brigham City refund policy applies as follows: Cancellation by user 15 to 30 days prior to use is a full refund, minus \$5.00 handling charge. Cancellations less than 15 days, no refund allowed.
3. Cancellation of an event due to weather, facility or field conditions, or city-declared emergency will be rescheduled, if possible, or refunded. Playability of fields will be determined by the Parks Supervisor no later than 3 p.m. Monday through Friday. Rainout information for Saturday play will be relayed to the designated user group contact from the Parks Division.
4. Amplified sound equipment must be consistent with the City's as by special event resolution.
5. Users shall abide by sport or event-specific rules and field usage rules. All games and practice games need to be scheduled and fees paid through Brigham City. A game is defined by any one of the following criteria:
 - a. If there is more than one team present
 - b. If there are officials present, certified or not, or coaches acting as officials
 - c. If players are in uniform
 - d. If one of the teams travels to game site from another city or location
6. Pursuant to Title 17 of the Brigham City Code, the Community Activities and Services Department (CAS) shall have control over all concession stands or dispensaries that sell any items to the public in any public park or playground. An approval from the CAS Department must be obtained and a license purchased from the City licensing department for the operation thereof.
7. A minimum of \$1,000,000.00 liability insurance policy, naming Brigham City Corporation as additional insured must be submitted with scheduling request for all users. In addition, User shall release, indemnify and hold harmless Brigham City Corporation, its elected and appointed officials, officers, employees and volunteers from any and all claims, damages, lawsuits, losses and expenses (including attorney fees) arising out of or resulting from User's performance or failure to perform this agreement and all of User's


activities conducted on City's facilities/property. Commercial and privately owned and operated program providers must provide proof of Worker's Compensation and Employee's Liability for employees of the organization as required by Utah State Law.


These fees, user groups and guidelines shall remain until such time as they are changed by the City Council.
