Due to the presence of COVID-19 (Coronavirus) cases in Utah, Brigham City Fire Department is taking steps to ensure the safety of our community and department employees. Brigham City Fire Department Administration has determined that it is in the best interest of the community and the Fire Department to minimize the risk associated with unnecessary exposure. Therefore, Brigham City Fire Department is suspending participation in any non-essential, public events and station tours until the threat posed by COVID-19, and exposure to it has subsided. Once the threat of COVID-19 has diminished, Brigham City Fire Department will resume scheduling and participating in public events and station tours.

Brigham City Fire Department will continue to respond to any-and-all calls for emergency assistance. Our department is taking the necessary precautions to protect our Firefighters and employees, so they may continue to serve our community.
