

Peach Days Deadline

Temporary Business Licenses:

Monday, August 27, 2018



Anyone desiring to set up a retail booth outside of the designated Peach Days T-Zone, may submit an application for a temporary business license. The proposed booth must be located on the pavement/parking lot of a commercial property. It cannot be on or blocking the sidewalk or in the street.

Requirements: a completed application, a letter of permission from the property owner, and a simple drawing of how and where your booth will be set up on that property. If you are a mobile food vendor, we will also need a copy of your Health Dept permit and your annual fire inspection report.
