

**BRIGHAM CITY CORPORATION
ELECTRIC SERVICE
SCHEDULE NO. 6**

GENERAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY: At any point on the City's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

Application: This schedule is for alternating current, single or three-phase service supplied at City's available voltage through one kilowatt-hour meter at a single point of delivery for all electric service required on the premises.

Energy Rate:	\$0.1200	per kwh first 500 kwh
	\$0.0880	per kwh next 7,500 kwh
	\$0.0538	per kwh all additional kwh

Power Factor: This rate is based on the customer maintaining at all times a power factor of 95% lagging, or higher, as determined by measurement. If the average power factor is found to be less than 95% lagging the power as recorded by the City's meter will be increased by 1% for every 1% that the power factor is less than 95%.

All installations of neon, fluorescent, mercury vapor lamps or tubes, or other types of gaseous lamps, or other devices having low power factor characteristics, installed or generally rearranged after the effective date of this Schedule will be supplied hereunder only if the overall power factor (including the auxiliaries) of such units or group of units is 95 percent lagging or higher.

Minimum Net:

\$9.57 plus **\$9.57** for each kw of power
over 10 kw, but not less than **\$29.45** for three phase service.

Power: The kw as shown by or computed from the readings of City's power meter, for the 15-minutes period of customer's greatest use during the month, determined to the nearest kw.
