

**BRIGHAM CITY CORPORATION
ELECTRIC SERVICE
SCHEDULE NO. 9**

GENERAL INDUSTRIAL SERVICE - HIGH VOLTAGE

AVAILABILITY: At any point on the City's interconnected system where there are facilities of adequate capacity.

Application: This schedule is for alternating current, three-phase service supplied at approximately 43,800 volts through a single point of delivery for all electric service required on the customer's premises for manufacturing or other industrial purposes by industrial customers contracting for no less than 80 kw and not more than 5,000 kw.

Service under this Schedule is limited to a maximum power requirement of 10,000 kw. When a customer's load reaches a level in excess of 10,000 kw, continued service will require special contract arrangement. This Schedule is not available to new loads in excess of 10,000 kw. In this latter case, a maximum power requirement in excess of 10,000 kw shall be deemed to exist when a customer's maximum power requirement exceeds 10,000 kw in at least three (3) months of any continuous period of six (6) successive months.

MONTHLY BILL:

Power Rate:

Effective daily 0700 hours through 2300 hours except Sundays.

\$8.56 per kw

Energy Rate:

\$0.0452 per kwh for all kwh

Power Factor: This rate is based on the customer maintaining an average power factor of 95% lagging, or higher, as determined by measurement. If the power factor is found to be less than 95% lagging, the demand as recorded by the City's meter will be increased by 1% for every 1% that the power factor is less than 95%.

Billing Demand: The kw as shown by or computed from readings of the City's power meter for the 15-minute period of the customer's greatest use during the month, adjusted for power factor as specified, determined to the nearest kw but not less than 70% of the greatest demand in kw imposed on the City by the customer in any of the preceding twelve (12) billing months.

Minimum: The monthly power charge, as defined above, but not less than
