Health Department Looking for Volunteers

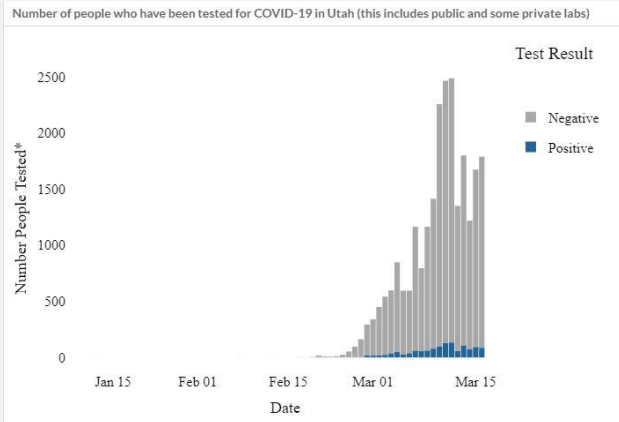
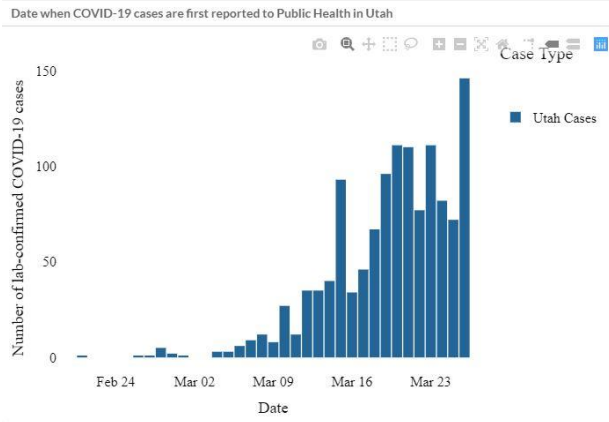
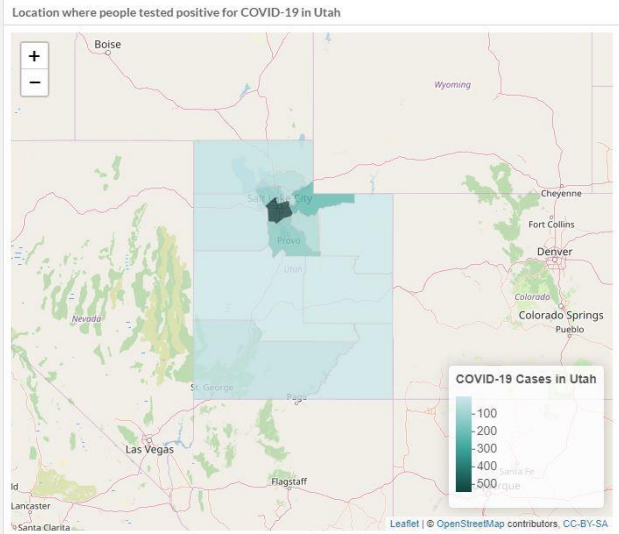

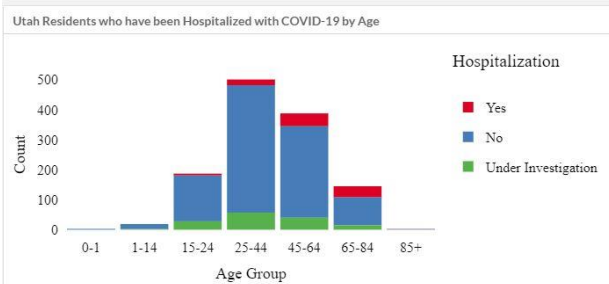
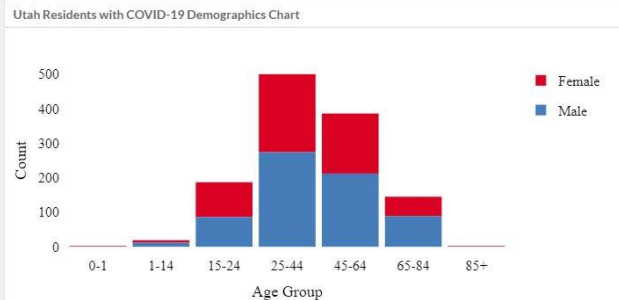
