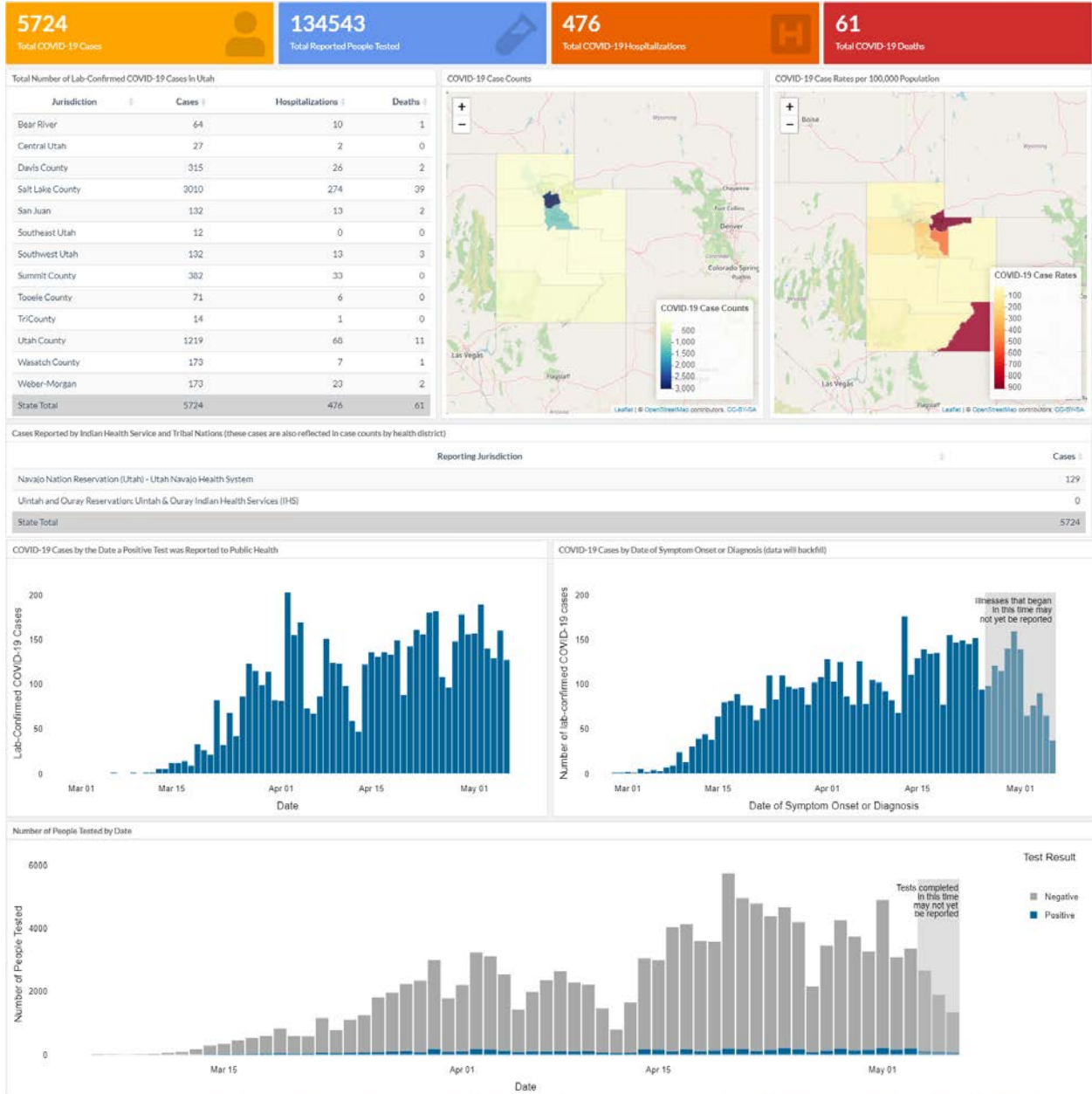
BEAR RIVER HEALTH DEPARTMENT UPDATES

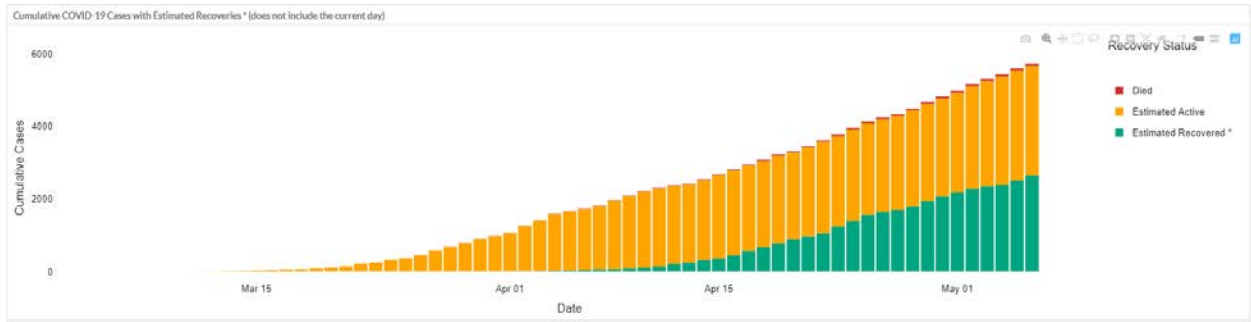
Bear River Health Department counts recoveries from COVID-19 as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). An individual must meet the following criteria to discontinue home isolation and be considered recovered:

- 1 – At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
- 2 – Improvement in respiratory symptoms; and
- 3 – At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared. This is a recent change in CDC guidance. Previous guidance listed 7 days instead of 10 days.

Epidemiological staff at BRHD are in regular contact with each individual that has tested positive for COVID-19. When the individual meets the criteria listed above they are considered recovered. We are fortunate to have this relationship with these individuals so we can provide accurate information instead of estimates.
