

# Whispers of Autumn Class

Pattern by Kim Diehl

Welcome! This class will help you learn the blocks that make up this beautiful quilt. Depending on your fabrics, you can make this quilt as scrappy as you want to make it.

## Materials and requirements for today's class:

- Whispers of Autumn pattern by Kim Diehl
- Fabric: Please have enough of your fabrics cut out for two of each of the block patterns. The following is the minimum fabric requirements for the blocks you will make in class if you are not able to have your cutting completed prior to class. **IMPORTANT:** Please label each set of fabric pieces you cut with their corresponding letter. This will make things go much smoother. 😊 Please bring all your fabric with you to class in case we need to cut an extra piece. Please reach out if you have any questions.

### ○ **Goose on the Loose blocks:**

- Creams:
  - Two (2) 3-1/2" squares of each of the cream fabrics - A
  - Four (4) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles of each of the cream fabrics – B
  - Four (4) 2-1/2" squares of each of the cream fabrics - C
- Main Block color (called first prints in the pattern):
  - Two (2) 3-1/2" squares each of two secondary block colors- D
  - Four (4) 2-1/2" squares each of two second block colors - E
- Secondary block color (called second prints in the pattern):
  - Four (4) 3" squares each of two primary block colors - F
  - One (1) 2-1/2" square each of two primary block colors - G
- Greens:
  - Four (4) 2" squares of each of the green prints – H
  - Four (4) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles of each of the green fabrics – I

- **Nine Patch Star blocks:**

- Creams:

- Four (4) 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles of each of the cream fabrics – A2
    - Four (4) 3-1/2" squares of each of the cream fabrics – B2
    - Four (4) 1-3/4 x 2" rectangles of each of the cream fabrics – C2

- Star Point Colors:

- Eight (8) 2-1/2" squares each of two different star point colors – D2

- Nine Patch colored fabrics:

- To complete two nine patch star blocks you need a total of eight (8) 2" squares (E2) and two (2) 1-3/4" squares (F2) in a variety of prints. This is the scrappy part of the nine-patch block. There will be 5 colors per block and is best if they are all different fabrics.

- Sewing machine with quarter inch presser foot
- Thread, fabric pins, scissors, rotary cutter, and any other sewing items you prefer to use.
- Optional but highly recommended:
  - Alphabet fabric markers are a huge help when you are cutting out your fabrics and keeping them organized.
  - If you have your own small personal iron and ironing mat, please bring them!
  - Creative Grids 6-1/2" square ruler
  - Creative Grids 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" ruler
  - Fabric marking pencil
  - Stiletto

This quilt is made up of alternating the two types of quilt blocks, adding the sashing and finishes at approximately 56-1/2" x 56-1/2" square. If you would like to make this quilt larger, you can add additional rows of blocks.
