Agreement for Charity Quilting

Mission Statement:

Quilt Love Longarm desires to support our local Guilds or Volunteer Groups that already have established philanthropic ventures by finishing a fixed number of computerized edge-2-edge quilts each month free of charge.

How it works:

Guilds or Volunteer Groups may request a trial partnership with Quilt Love Longarm for computerized quilting on charitable projects.

Guilds or Volunteer Groups must read and agree to our terms and conditions.

Guilds or Volunteer Groups must provide Quilt Love Longarm with a current copy of their 501-C3 non-profit status paperwork.

Guilds or Volunteer Groups must provide Quilt Love Longarm with a designated contact person that will handle **all** pick-ups and drop offs.

Guilds or Volunteer Groups must provide Quilt Love Longarm with a quilt top that is ready to be quilted, backing fabric that is 8" larger than the width and the length of the quilt top, and batting.

Quilt Love Longarm will provide the thread and the computerized edge-2-edge patterns. The thread color and computerized edge-2-edge patterns will be chosen by the quilter.

Quilt Love Longarm will do its best to have the quilts completed within 6 weeks of intake but that is not guaranteed.

Quilt Love Longarm reserves the right to limit quilt submissions by local Guilds or Volunteer Groups, or to disperse quilts to be completed over several months.
