This fun bag can be personalized and carries not only your water bottle, but includes a zippered and a patch pocket to carry what you need like your ID, phone, keys. It's so handy when you are out hiking or at the beach. The front pocket can be embellished with embroidery, applique, even heat transfer vinyl. If you do want to embellish the pocket, please have the embellishment



prepared for the first class. The embroidery or HTV should not be more than 4" x 4".

*If you want to waterproof your exterior or lining, you can use Odicoat and treat the fabric 24 hours before you cut it out.

Description: Has binding your quilt got you in a bind? Join Jennifer for this in-depth basics class on machine binding. We will cover how to trim your quilted piece for binding, how to calculate how much fabric to purchase (manually and time saving computer calculation on your cell phone), make our binding strips with a

bias/diagonal join and machine bind with atraditional $2\,\%$ " double fold binding. There will also be plenty of tips and tricks to help get neat, mitered corners and manage the bulk of larger sized projects. It is recommended you bring a project no larger than ~25" x 25" so that you will have time to finish during the class session.

Saturday, August 30 - Meet Jean Wright, Former NASA Seamstress

Description: Have you ever wanted to meet a NASA seamstress? Now is your chance! Jean Wright is a former NASA Aerospace Composite Technician- a NASA seamstress. Jean worked with the United Space Alliance at the Thermal Protection System Facility at Kennedy Space Center in Florida. One of 18 seamstresses in this critical role, Jean and her co-workers dubbed their group, "The Sew Sisters", using machines and hand stitching to build, create and repair thermal protection flight hardware and parachutes. Wright worked on the Endeavor, Atlantis and Discovery space shuttle missions. She also worked on test parachutes and aft-skirt blankets for the Orion spacecraft.

Jean says she's retired, but she is a most incredible NASA advocate, photographer, speaker and representative. Jean remains involved with NASA as a Docent for the Shuttle Atlantis exhibit at the Kennedy Space Center.
