RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A (2) 2" × 2" squares Fabric 2:
- B (2) 2" × 2" squares Fabric 3:
- C (1) 3 %" × 3 %" square, cut in half diagonally once
- D (2) $2" \times 6 \%"$ rectangles*

Fabric 4:


- E (1) 3 %" × 3 %" square, cut in half diagonally once
- F (2) 2" × 6 ½" rectangles*

Fabric 5:

- G (1) 3 %" × 3 %" square, cut in half diagonally once
- H − (2) 2" × 6 ½" rectangles*

Fabric 6:

- I (1) 3 %" × 3 %" square, cut in half diagonally once
- J (2) 2" × 6 ½" rectangles*



*Note: D, F, H, and J have been slightly oversized for EASE of assembly. If you prefer to use a scant seam allowance, the original cutting found in the Cutting Guide is usable.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Arrange (2) **A**—squares and (2) **B**—squares as shown below. Sew the pieces together in pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make the Center Unit.






3. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle and (1) **F**-rectangle together to make a



2. Sew (1) **D**—rectangle and (1) **J**—rectangle together to make a D/J unit. Repeat to make (2) total units.



4. Sew (1) **E**—triangle and (1) **I**—triangle together as shown to make an E/I unit. Repeat to make (2) total units.








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
5. Sew (1) **C**-triangle and (1) **G**-triangle together as shown to make a C/G unit. Repeat to make (2) total units.




6. Sew (1) E/I unit to the left side and (1) C/G unit to the right side of (1) D/J unit as shown below to make (1) Triangle Unit. Repeat to make (2) total units.




7. Sew (1) F/H unit to each side of (1) Center Unit. (Pay attention to the orientation of the units.) Press. Next, sew (1) Triangle Unit to the top and (1) Triangle Unit to the bottom. Press.



8. Trim the Step 7 unit to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make Block 12.
