Monday, February 2 & Friday, February 6 - Everything But The Machine Tote Class with Linda

Cost: \$50, plus supplies

Location: Quilts and Lace, Melbourne, 10am - 5pm (February 2); 10am - 4pm (February 6)

Description: The Everything But the Machine Tote is a great way to have your supplies at hand wherever you go. The tote is designed to have a small Sterilite® 5 drawer unit inside. This is a great class for the student who has done some bagmaking before, but wants to take their skills to the next level.

Monday, February 2 OR Thursday, February 5 - Radiance/Aveneer Lecture/Demo with Beth (Session 3)

Cost: Free for Radiance/Aveneer machines purchased at Quilts and Lace or at Sweet Time Quilting; \$120 per class if your machine was purchased elsewhere.

Location: Sweet Time Quilting, Sebastian, 1pm - 3pm (February 2)

Description: This is the perfect class for new Baby Lock Radiance or Brother Aveneer owners. This session will focus on the embroidery features of the machine.

Cost: Free for Baby Lock machines purchased at Quilts and Lace or at Sweet Time Quilting; \$90 per class if your machine was purchased elsewhere.

Location: Sweet Time Quilting, Sebastian, 9:30am - 11:30am (February 5 & 12)

Description: Serger 1 is an introductory course on the Baby Lock 4-8 thread sergers. This class is highly recommended for new Baby Lock serger owners. Learn the basics of threading and overlock methods. In Serger 3, continue your serger journey and further expand your knowledge with tips to make the job easier.

Tuesday, February 3 & Thursday, February 5 - Celtic Love Heart Table Topper with Sue

Cost: \$30, plus supplies

Location: Quilts and Lace, Melbourne, 10:30am - 2:30pm (February 3 & 5)

Description: Perfect for Valentine's Day or St Patrick's Day decorating! This table topper has a machine embroidery design center, with all of the blocks made in the 5 x 7, 6 x 10 or 7 x 12 hoop. There is one heart panel, which you will stitch out six times. The panels are made completely in the hoop, with a small amount of hand stitching or fabric glue to close them up, then join with your sewing machine. Each leaf panel is just slightly smaller than the hoop size you use to make it.



Saturday, February 7 OR Saturday, February 21 - Sewing 1 with Jennifer

Cost: Free for Brother, Baby Lock or Janome machines purchased at Quilts and Lace or at Sweet Time Quilting; \$90 per class if your machine was purchased elsewhere.

Sweet Time Quilting, Sebastian, 9:30am - 12pm (February 21 & 28)

Description: Sewing 1 is the course you want to take to learn the basics about your new sewing machine as we make a darling little drawstring pouch. Learn how to navigate around your machine, change a needle, wind a bobbin, thread your machine, troubleshoot, how to clean your machine and other best practices and techniques. In Sewing 2, learn what all those presser feet that came with your machine can do. Zipper foot, buttonhole, blind hem and overcast are some of the feet you will cover in this class as we make a fun zipper pouch. Please remember to bring your machine, manual, accessories and presser feet with you to class. Fabric kits are provided for students in each class.

Some of the topics we will cover are: basic terms and information for embroidery software, standard file structure to help you understand where and how to store your designs to find them later, how to download purchased designs, how to unzip designs and copy designs from a computer to a USB (to be used on your embroidery machine). Topics will include proper design placement, editing your design then saving the design to stitch out your masterpiece on your jacket at home! Since stitching out your design will be completed at home, it is optional to bring your machine to class. You will, however, need to bring your iPad with the Janome Apps loaded onto it.
