
#### Saturday, July 5 - Meet the Author: D.A. Simpson


#### Monday, July 7 OR Tuesday, July 8 - Embroidery 1 with Beth






#### Wednesday, July 16 & 30 - "Pink Lemonade" Tumbler Quilt with Karen
