



Sewing Room Blooms

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Who doesn't love pretty flowers? Here's a fun way to add tabletop blooms to your sewing room! Use them to store binding clips, bobbins and more.

Materials: 1 floriori Mini Charm Pack
1 - 10" square batting
1 - 6" square of batting

1. Separate fabric into 2 groups of 16 charms and two groups of 4 charms. Sew together to create two 8½" and two 4½" blocks. There will be 2 charms leftover.

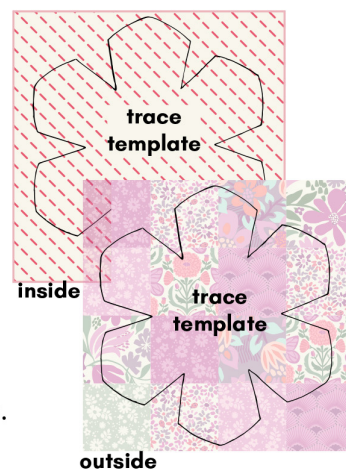

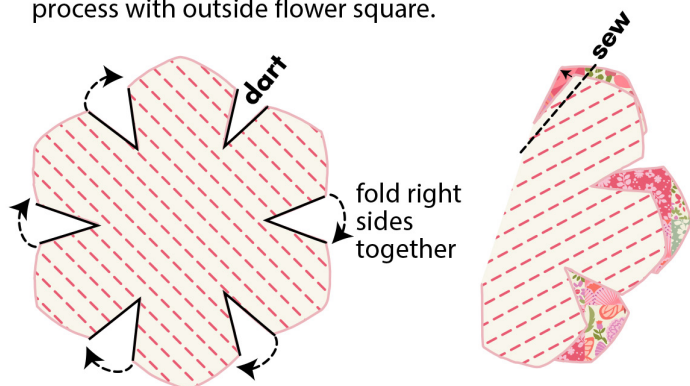

2. Decide which block will be the "inside" and "outside" of the flower. With right side up, layer the "inside" block with square of batting and quilt as desired. Trim to 8½". The outside block does not get quilted.



3. Trace flower template to wrong sides of both squares. Cut out along outline.

4. Working with inside flower square, fold and align darts along each petal with right sides together. Sew a scant ¼" seam. Continue with all darts. Repeat same process with outside flower square.



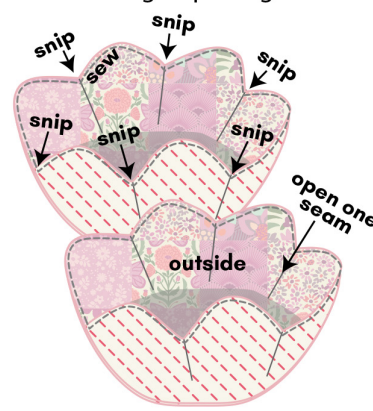
fold right sides together

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5. With right sides together, nest outside/inside flower. Pin at seams. Sew scant ¼" around top of the flowers.



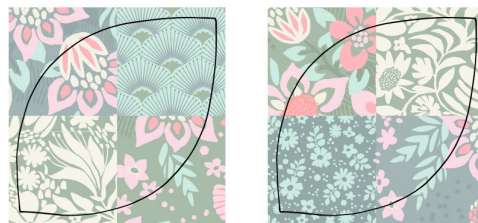
6. Snip petal corners being careful not to cut sewn seam. Seam rip one dart seam on "outside" flower. Turn inside out through opening.



7. Hand stitch to close seam on outside flower. Machine sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around top edge.



8. Make Leaf. Trace leaf template on back sides of both $4\frac{1}{2}$ " leaf blocks. Cut out along drawn line.



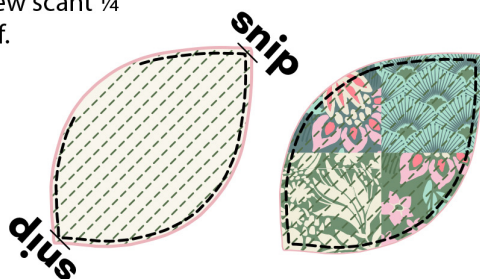
9. With right side up, layer one leaf with batting. Quilt as desired. Trim to leaf shape.



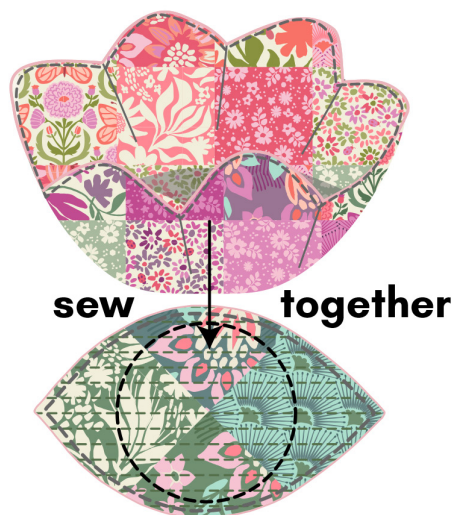
10. With right sides together, sew leaf layers together with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, leaving an opening to turn inside out.



11. Snip ends of leaf close to seam to reduce bulk. Turn leaf inside out. Hand-stitch seam closed. To finish, sew scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " around leaf.



12. Center flower on leaf and sew together. I found a 2" circle secured the flower very well.



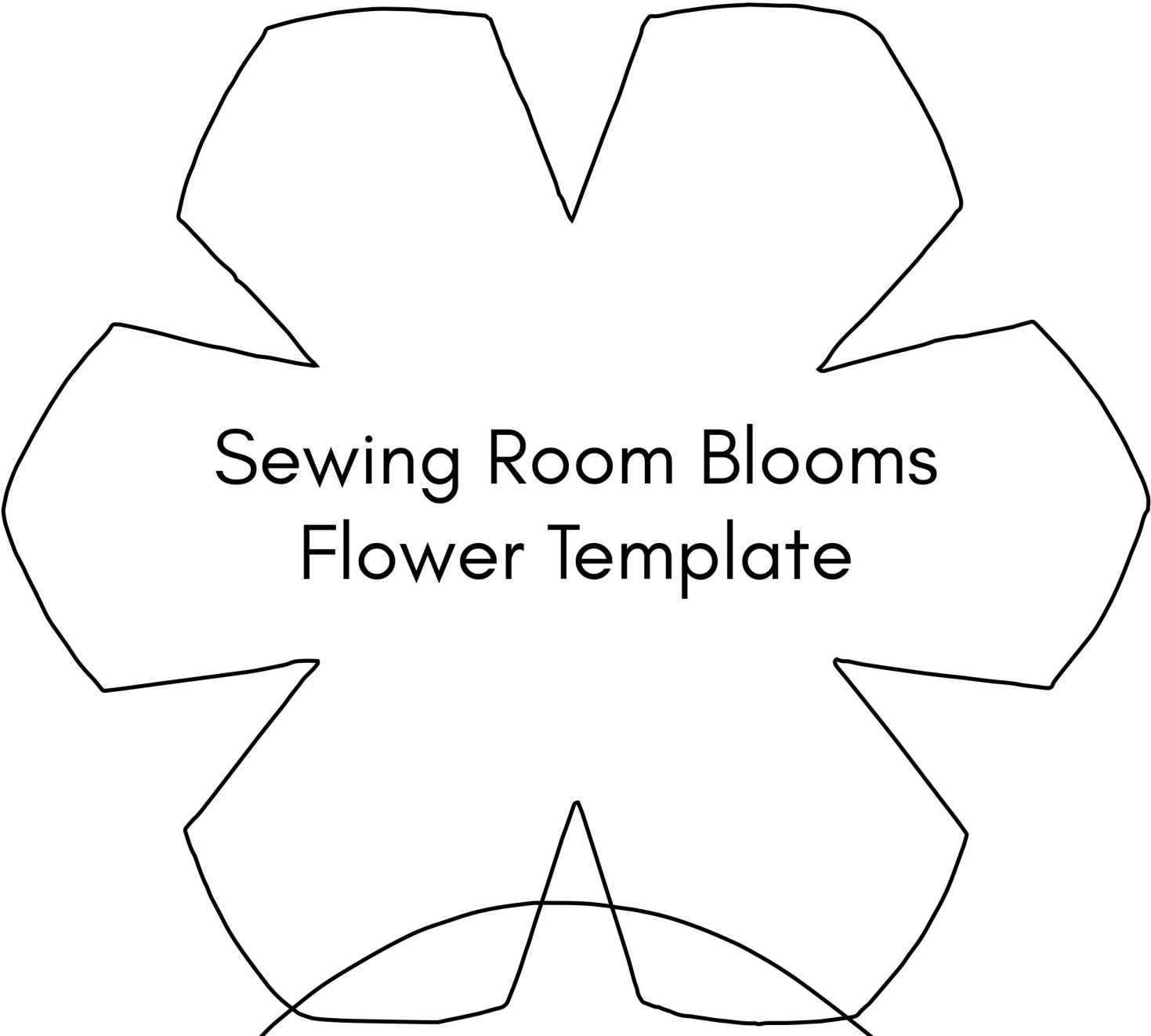

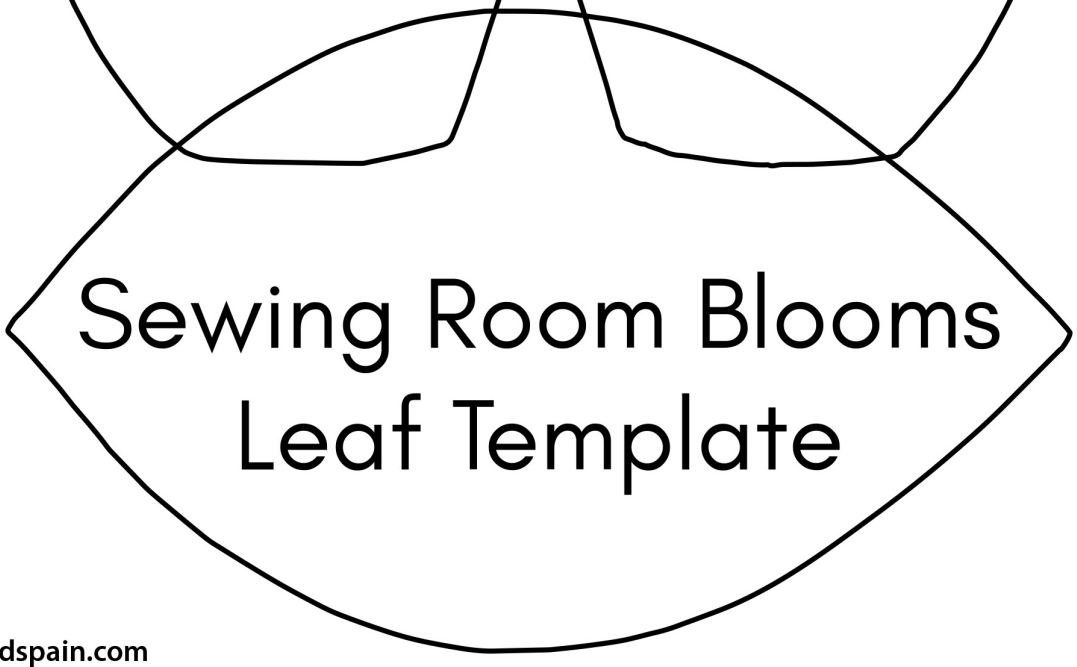
