

# Block 1: Christmas Star

## Cut:

From assorted red prints, cut:

A- (4) 3.5 inch squares

B- (4) 4 inch squares

From assorted green prints, cut:

C- (4) 2.5 inch squares


From background, cut:

D- (4) 2.5 X 1.5 inch rectangles

E- (4) 3.5 X 1.5 inch rectangles

F- (4) 4 inch squares

G- (1) 2.5 x 13.5 rectangle




## Piece:

Sew (1) D rectangle to the left side of (1) C square.


Sew (1) E rectangle to the top of the unit you just made.

Make 4 Green Units



Draw a diagonal line on the back of (4) F squares. Place each F square right sides together with a B square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 8 half square triangles. Trim to 3.5" square.



Assemble (1) Green Unit, 2 half square triangles and (1) A square to make a quadrant as shown in the illustration above. Make 4 **identical** quadrants.

Follow the Finishing Instructions on Page 7 to complete your Christmas Star block.

Attach (1) G rectangle to the **bottom** of your block.

# Block 2: Cadence

## Cut:

From (8) dark green prints, cut:


A- (8) 4 inch squares

From (8) medium green prints, cut:

B- (8) 4 inch squares

From background, cut:


C- (1) 2.5 x 13.5 rectangle



## Piece:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of (8) B squares. Place each B square right sides together with an A square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 16 half square triangles. Trim to 3.5" square.



Assemble (4) half square triangles like quadrant 1 above, make 2 pinwheel blocks.

Assemble (4) half square triangles like quadrant 2 above, make 2 pinwheel blocks.

Follow the Finishing Instructions on Page 7 to complete your Cadence block. Pay close attention to the direction of the pinwheels.

Attach (1) C rectangle to the **top** of your block.

# Block 3: Plaid Pinwheel

## Cut:

From assorted red prints, cut:

A- (6) 4 inch squares

From assorted dark green prints, cut:

B- (2) 4 inch squares

From assorted medium green prints, cut:

C- (4) 4 inch squares


From assorted light green prints, cut:

D- (2) 4 inch squares

From background, cut:

E- (2) 4 inch squares


F- (1) 2.5 x 13.5 rectangle



## Piece:


Draw a diagonal line on the back of (2) A squares. Place each A square right sides together with a B square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 4 half square triangles. Trim to 3.5" square.



Repeat the above with (4) C squares and (4) A squares. Make 8 hst. Trim to 3.5" square

Repeat the above with (2) E rectangles and (2) D rectangles. Make 4 hst. Trim to 3.5" square.



Assemble (1) dark green/red hst, (2) medium green/red hst and (1) light green/white hst to make a quadrant as shown in the illustration at the top of the page. Make 4 **identical** quadrants.

Follow the Finishing Instructions on Page 7 to complete your Plaid Pinwheel block.

Attach (1) F rectangle to the **bottom** of your block.

# Block 4: Polar Bear Express

## Cut:

From red prints, cut:

A- (4) 4.5 inch squares

From light green prints, cut:

B- (8) 3 inch squares


C- (4) 2.5 inch squares

From dark green prints, cut:

D- (8) 3 inch squares

From background, cut:


E- (1) 2.5 x 13.5 rectangle



## Piece:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of (8) B squares. Place each B square right sides together with a D square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 16 half square triangles. Trim to 2.5" square.




Assemble (1) C square with (2) half square triangles as shown below. (top unit)

Assemble (2) half square triangles ,one on top of the other as shown below. (side unit)

Attach the side unit to the left side of the red square.

Attach the top unit to the unit you just made.

Make 4 identical quadrants.



Follow the Finishing Instructions on Page 7 to complete your Polar Bear Express block.

Attach (1) E rectangle to the **top** of your block.

# Block 5: Mom's Dishes

## Cut:

From assorted red prints, cut:

A- (4) 4 inch squares


From assorted dark green prints, cut:

B- (8) 4 inch squares

From background, cut:

C- (4) 4 inch squares


D- (1) 2.5 x 13.5 rectangle




## Piece:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of (4) A squares. Place each A square right sides together with a B square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 8 half square triangles. Trim to 3.5" square.



Repeat the above with (4) C squares and (4) A squares. Make 8 hst. Trim to 3.5" square



Assemble (2) dark green/red hst and (2) dark green/ white hst to make a quadrant as shown in the illustration at the top of the page. Make 4 **identical** quadrants.

Follow the Finishing Instructions on Page 7 to complete your Mom's Dishes block.

Attach (1) D rectangle to the **bottom** of your block.

# Block Finishing (add the ribbons)

## Cut:

From ribbon print, cut:

T- (5) 4 inch squares

U- (10) 1.5 x 6.5 rectangles

V- (5) 1.5 x 13.5 rectangles


W- (5) 1.5 x 1.5 squares

From background, cut:

X- (5) 4 inch square

Y- (5) 1.5 x 2.5 inch rectangle


Z- (10) 3.5 inch squares



## Piece:

Draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) X square. Place each X square right sides together with a T square and sew 1/4 inch from the drawn line on both sides.

Cut on the line you drew. You now have 10 half square triangles. Trim to 3.5" square.



Assemble (1) W square and (1) Y rectangle at the short end. Assemble that unit, 2 half square triangles, and (2) Z squares as shown below (bow unit). Make 5 bow units.


Assemble quadrants 1 and 3 of your block with (1) U rectangle between.

Repeat for quadrants 2 and 4.

Assemble the 2 quadrant units with (1) V rectangle.

Attach the bow unit to the top of the unit you just made.

Repeat for all blocks. Some quadrants will need to be rotated, pay close attention to the illustrations.



# Runner Finishing

## Cut:

From background, cut:

A- (4) 2.5 inch width of fabric strips

B- (6) 2.5 inch X 18.5 rectangles



## Piece:

Sew your 5 quilt blocks in a row as shown in the above illustration with a B rectangle between each

Attach (1) B rectangle to the left side of the blocks you just assembled. Repeat on the right side.

Sew (2) A strips together end to end and trim to 2.5 X 77.5 inches. Repeat with the other (2) A strips

Attach one strip you just made to the top of the blocks. Repeat on the bottom.

Quilt and bind as desired.

Ta-da, you are done!



# Wrap it Up!

22.5" x 77.5"

Skill level: Easy, suitable for beginners

## Materials Needed

QB001

Assorted Red Prints: scraps at least 4.5 inches big (or .5 yard)

Assorted Green Prints (light, medium and dark): scraps at least 4 inches big (or .5 yard dark, fat quarter of light and medium)

Accent Print (for ribbons): 1 fat quarter

Background: 1.5 yards

Binding: .5 yard

Backing: 2.5 yards

I used Art Gallery Pure Solids in Undeniably Red, Hunter Fields, Patina Green, Sprout, Honey and Snow.

## General Instructions:

Please read through the pattern before beginning to make sure you understand the steps!

Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

**I press my seams open but you can press to the dark side if you prefer**
