Perry City Municipal 2021 Election

Ballots were mailed on October 12, 2021. Ballots must be postmarked by November 1, 2021 to be valid for the election. You can drop your ballots off at the City office in the drop box outside through Election Day. Provisional ballot voting will be available in person on November 2nd, from 7:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. at the Perry City Office building. You will need to bring proof of residency and ID.



STORM DRAINS

Please keep your leaves cleaned up and out of the gutters so they do not block/clog up the storm drains.

SNOW REMOVAL

Landowners are responsible to keep sidewalks adjacent to their property accessible and cleared of debris, vegetation, and snow in order to be compliant with Perry City ordinances and reduce their personal liability. Also as winter approaches, in order to allow for snow removal, **vehicles and trailers are not allowed to be parked on public streets within 48 hours immediately following any snowfall.**

PLACE: Walker Cinemas

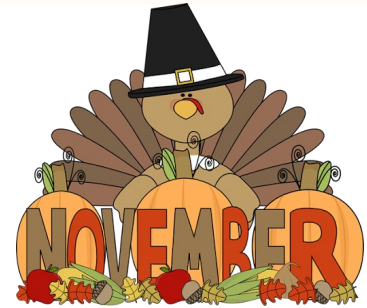

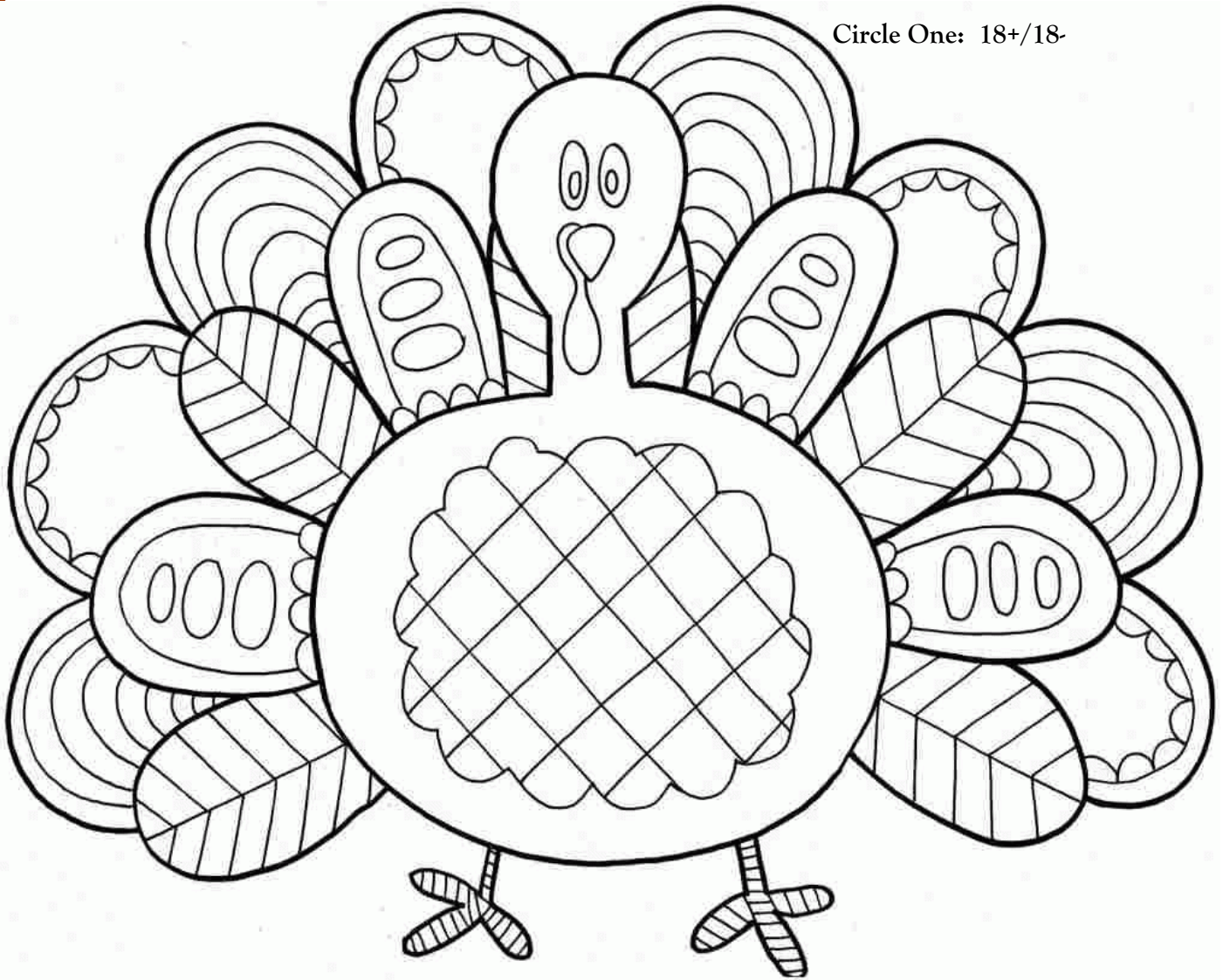
