He stated that this signage is just temporary and will get us by until the council decides on a more permanent city sign. He mentioned that he had examples of A-framed signs that might be used inside or outside of the building at the open house. Council Member Young said there was a company that rents signs, for example, they might want to rent a big sign that said "Open House" to go in from of the building along the highway.

Ms. Johnson said she thinks with the A-frames signs, and the open house signs, and the balloons will be eye catching. She mentioned that she sent the public open house invitation to the Tourism and Chamber of Commerce and asked them to post it on their website. She noted that Box Elder County had already posted it to their website.

Council Member Young said that the balloon vendor would be there Tuesday morning at 8 am to start putting up the balloon art.

The attendees toured the building and discussed logistics for the open house.
