ITEM 1: CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jeppsen called the electronic City Council meeting to order. A. Resolution 2020-23 Adopting The 2020 Bear River Region, Utah Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan

She explained that she was just informed of the new requirement from our Auditor the day prior. She reviewed the results of the assessment, which indicated that the City was a low fraud risk (with a score of 330). She noted areas the city could improve i.e. credit card policy. Council Member Ostler asked why the council is involved in the assessment. Ms. Johnson advised that the auditor wants the City Council to be

aware of the results and any risk that may exist. Shanna advised that the Council could change the motion from approving the report to acknowledging receipt of the report.
