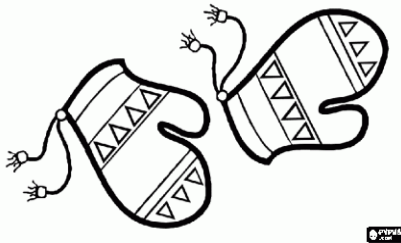


PERRY C.E.R.T.
