A. <u>Application for a subdivision amendment/ lot line adjustment for Kerr Subdivision. Located</u> <u>2925 South Hwy 89. Applicant Jeff Kerr.</u>

He said the City Engineer is still seeking more information regarding storm water collection. He said there are still a few minor details needing to be addressed but they are getting closer.

The Commission discussed the landscape buffer for this application.

The Commission agreed to table this item until the applicant provides a set timeline regarding their plans for the storm water collection, as well as, the plans for the landscaping buffer.

The Commission and Staff discussed the regulations of pedestrian friendly areas, as well as, possibly utilizing an active transportation plan. The Commission and Staff discussed utilizing and regulating sidewalks and trails.

The Commission and Staff discussed regulating maintenance and requiring the same standards of maintenance as time passes.

The Commission and Staff discussed regulating the lighting of multi-family developments.

The Commission and Staff discussed the regulations of developments on the highway versus other areas in the City.

The Commission and Staff further discussed building esthetics and used Roy City's language as an example.
