## Fiscal Year 2019 Budget

On June 14, 2018 the Perry City Mayor & Council passed a final budget for Fiscal Year 2019. The budget includes the following projects and improvements:

- Going Paperless including fillable online forms
- Online Timekeeping & Payroll Integration
- Social Media Upgrades & Records Archiving
- Police Safety Equipment & 2 New Patrol Vehicles
- Park Restroom Fixture Upgrades
- Tree Maintenance & Removal
- 2 New Public Works Vehicles
- Signage at Three Mile Creek Elementary (speed limit, lighted)
- Road Improvements at 2700 South & 750 West
- Increased Fire Contract Fee
- Online Work Order System
- SCADA system for Wal-Mart Lift Station
- Gun Range Grant Projects (storage building, parking & short range firing line)
- Competitive Market Salary Increases based on survey
- Corridor Preservation
- New Playground Equipment at Mountain View Park

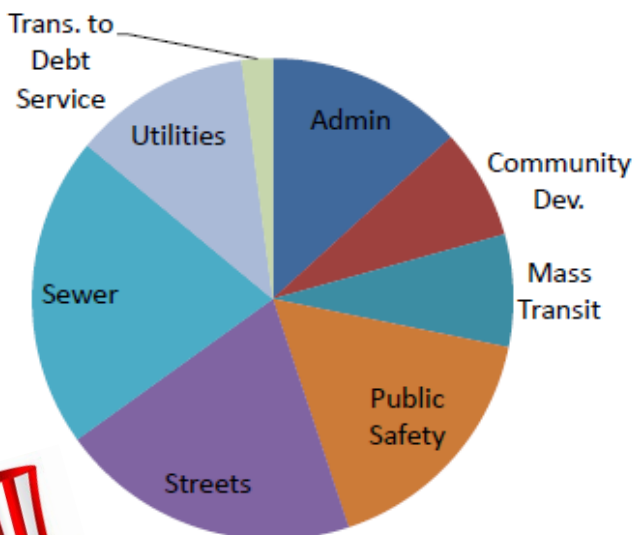

General Fund: \$3,900,540    Utility Fund: \$691,735    Sewer Fund: \$1,216,292

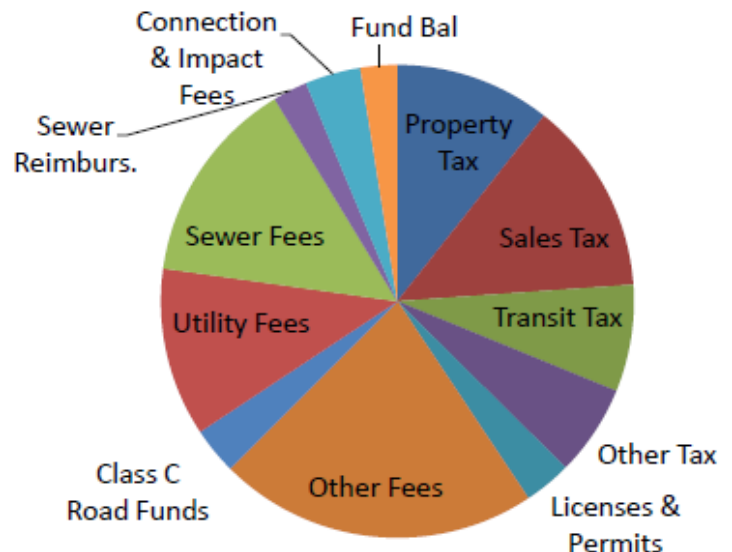
