WEEDS IN PERRY

10.17.020 Regulation

It shall be unlawful for any person or entity owning, having charge or control of or occupying any real estate abutting on any street within the City to fail, refuse or neglect to remove all weeds and noxious vegetation from the curb line to the inside line of public sidewalks. All property owners are responsible for taking care of the weeds on their own property. If this code is not adhered to, you will receive a letter, and then a penalty will follow.

COMMERCIAL TRUCKS PARKED ON CITY STREETS

15.19.171.2 Regulation

No person shall operate or park any commercial vehicle on any street within any residential area or residential zoning district of Perry City.
