FYI If you are delinquent on your payment for utilities and your water is turned off at the meter you **will now be assessed a \$50.00 fee** to turn your water back on.

Per city ordinance :

12.11.020 BILLING FOR NON PAYMENT

(Section 5)

Before water service to said premises shall again be provided all water, sewer and garbage charges due must have been paid to the City office, together with such extra charges for turning on the water as the City Council may have established by resolution. At the date of the ordinance codified in this chapter fifty dollars (\$50.00) is the fee adopted.

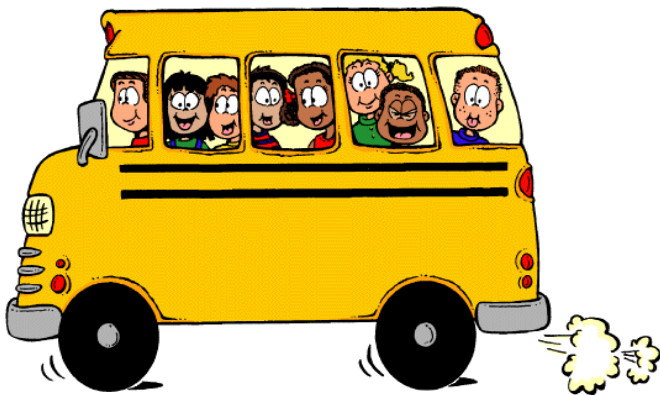


BURN PERMITS

Before you burn your spring trimmings, you must first obtain a burn permit. There is no cost. Permits are issued by Brigham City and can be obtained by going online thru Perry City's web page under frequently requested there is a link for open burning permits. Permits will be available on days with good air quality, and fires must be put out by dark. Open burn goes from March 1st to May 31st.

WILLARD/PERRYKINDERGARTEN ROUND-UP

Children who will be five years of age BEFORE Sept. 1, 2019 are about to start a wonderful, exciting adventure. At this time Willard Elementary is trying to locate incoming kindergarten students in the Willard/Perry communities. If you have a child eligible for kindergarten, please contact the school by calling 435-734-4934, or you could just stop by the school at 40 W 50 S in Willard between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM.



GREEN WASTE

Perry City will no longer be operating a Green Waste Facility. It is no longer economically feasible and there are environmental issues related to the burning or disposal of the green waste. The City is currently in conversations with Brigham city for a possible agreement to use their green waste facility. In the meantime, Perry residents can take their green waste to the Brigham City facility for \$7 per load, or residents can utilize their garbage receptacles for green waste and get an additional garbage can if needed for the price of \$10 per month.



Another option is to use the newly implemented Perry Resident Landfill Vouchers to dispose of green waste or other waste you may have. Each resident is entitled to one voucher per year, which allows free use of the Box Elder County Landfill (limited to one truckload, all loads must be covered). This program was developed to replace the City Spring cleanup. You can access your free voucher from the city website. It takes 1-2 business days for the voucher to be approved. We will publish any updates in regards to green waste as they become available.

We apologize for any inconvenience and hope you will understand the City's efforts to protect the environment and ensure responsible spending. We also hope you will take advantage of one of the above listed options as a solution to your waste disposal needs.

DOG LICENSES & BUSINESS LICENSES
