ITEM 1: CANVASS OF THE 2017 GENERAL ELECTION (SUSAN OBRAY), INCL. MOTION TO CERTIFY ELECTION RESULTS

Susan Obray reviewed the following 2017 Municipal Election Results:

- Total Registered Voters: 2624
- Ballots Cast: 1077- 41.04%
- Ballots Counted on Election Night: 1031- 39.29%
- Ballots Post Marked by November 7th: 14
- Ballots Post Marked after November 7th: 0
- Ballots received before November 7th which were marked undeliverable: 24
- There were 30 voted provisional ballots counted and 9 not counted (due to no record of previous registration).
- After counting the valid ballots and provisional ballots, the percentage of ballots counted was 41.04%.
