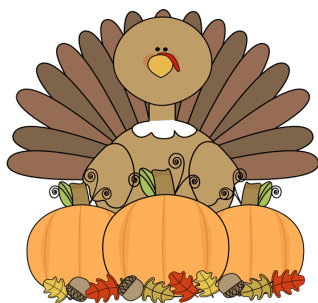
2020 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 3

Ballots were mailed on October 13, 2020. Ballots must be postmarked by November 2, 2020 to be valid for the election. You can drop your ballots off at the City office in the drop box outside through Election Day. If you would like to vote in person on November 3rd, there will be a polling location at USU Brigham City in the Student Service Building at 989 S Main from 7:00 a.m.– 8:00 p.m. Same day voter registration will be available on Election Day through a provisional ballot. You will need to bring proof of residency and ID. Masks will be required.



SNOW REMOVAL

Landowners are responsible to keep sidewalks adjacent to their property accessible and cleared of debris, vegetation, and snow in order to be compliant with Perry City ordinances and reduce their personal liability. Also as winter approaches, in order to allow for snow removal, **vehicles and trailers are not allowed to be parked on public streets within 48 hours immediately following any snowfall.**

ANNUAL PERRY CITY HOLIDAY MOVIE

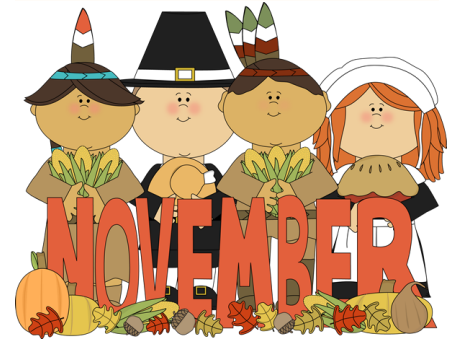
This year's movie will be "Dr. Suess' The Grinch".
