They are \$10 and it gives you 2 passes to the Box Elder County Landfill. Each pass is good for one small truck or trailer load. You may purchase as many as you like until we run out. They don't expire until May of 2023.



PERRY CITY C.E.R.T. UPDATE

Perry City CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) has been on hold as we maneuver through this pandemic. We are hoping to get busy again with monthly training for trained CERT and classes for new CERT trainees. We will begin our monthly training again (remotely through zoom) in October and November with no training in December. The Zoom training will be at our usual time, the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m., with radio call in at 6:30 from your home. Find your FRS radios, charge them, and turn to station 22.01 to participate in the radio call in. New CERT classes will hopefully begin in spring of 2022, depending on the situation with the pandemic. Watch for updates and information as we get closer to spring.

CERT classes have excellent training and information to help you, your family, and your community in an emergency. We encourage everyone to watch for classes coming up. It's a great way to be involved in neighborhood and community service. Let us know if anyone is interested in becoming more involved in the leadership of running the CERT program. We are always looking for willing hearts and hands as personal circumstances allow.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

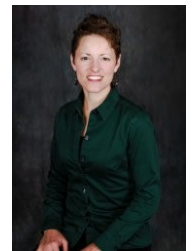
