You DO NOT need to call if you do not currently have a recycle can.



GRAVEL AND DIRT ON PERRY CITY RIGHT OF WAY

Please be advised that dumping sand, gravel, topsoil, or other material on public streets or right of way is NOT permitted. Dumping or stockpiling such material in the right of way violates storm water pollution regulations of the State of Utah, which Perry City is obligated to enforce. In addition, such actions violate local Perry City ordinances. Perry city employees are actively distributing informational handouts when they see a concern. These are not citations, however in some circumstances a citation may be warranted. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

PEACH BROWN BETTY (Mels Kitchen Café)

Ingredients

TOPPING:

- 4 Slices thick and hearty bread (white or whole wheat)
- 5 Tablespoons cold butter, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 1 Tablespoon granulated sugar
- 1/4 Teaspoon ground cinnamon

PEACH FILLING


- 2 Tablespoons butter
- 3 1/2 pounds peaches, peeled, pitted, and cut into 1/2 inch wedges (you can substitute 3 pounds of frozen peaches that have been thawed and drained)
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 Tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 Teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/8 teaspoon salt

BURN PERMITS

LANDFILL VOUCHER

If you have not received your free landfill voucher yet, you can still get one! With fall cleanup, now would be a great time to use it! One voucher per household for Perry residents will give you a free small truck or trailer load to the Box Elder County Landfill. To get your voucher, you can go to the city website at www.perrycity.org and click on the Landfill Voucher button. After you fill out your information, you will receive an email with your voucher within 1-2 business days.



PINEVIEW WATER

It is anticipated that Pineview water will be turned off around October 15th this year.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees and make sure an oven rack is in the middle position. In a food processor, pulse the bread and butter until it is coarsely ground. Set aside. Combine the sugar and cinnamon together in a small bowl.
2. In a large nonstick oven safe skillet over medium heat, melt the butter and add the peaches, cooking them until they begin to caramelize, 8 to 12 minutes. Take the skillet off the heat and stir in 1 cup of the bread/butter crumb mixture, the sugars, lemon juice, vanilla and salt.
3. Top the peach mixture with the remaining bread crumbs and sprinkle with the cinnamon and sugar mixture. Bake in the preheated oven until the topping is golden brown and the juices are bubbling, about 20 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes. Serve warm with vanilla ice cream.
