B+ **I** COLOR AND GRAYSCALE: UP YOUR QUILT GAME BY WORKING WITH NEUTRALS!

"I love color. I love bright colors, and I love a lot of color in my quilts. So, imagine my surprise when I found myself attracted to grays and black and white in much of my recent work. All of a sudden, I was doing a lot of work in grayscale, and I was doing a bunch of experimenting with the juxtaposition of bright colors and neutrals. Because a lot of working with color is about value, it makes sense that working with grayscale would provide great experience in working with value without the distraction of color to muddy the waters." Who does that sound like? You guessed it, our very own Sarah Bond! Join Sarah in this very exciting, very creative, very eye-opening workshop where, through a number of exercises, you will work with neutrals to see where they will take you. You will be doing some compositions with grayscale solids and prints, then some with solid colors, and finally you will practice converting those solid color compositions to grayscale to understand the value in the color compositions that you are making. I MACHINE QUILTING - BEGINNING RULER WORK - SLIM

NOTE: REQUIRES SOME PROFICIENCY IN FREE MOTION QUILTING

Begin exploring the world of machine quilting with rulers with this Level 1 class using a straight quilting ruler. Susan will be using Slim by Angela Walters for Creative Grids, but any straight MACHINE QUILTING ruler you own will work. Why use a ruler and free motion quilting for straight lines? Because quilting straight lines with your feed dogs up and using a regular or walking foot requires you to spin your quilts as you follow the block lines. Using free motion and a straight machine quilting ruler eliminates this need, making straight line quilting on larger projects easier. We will be learning the properties of the particular ruler foot you purchase for your machine, quilting in the ditch, 1/4" quilting and border designs without the use of tape, point to point designs to fill squares and flying geese units, and we will introduce you to curve designs if you are working with "Slim" (or if your particular ruler has a curved end).

Please Note:

1. This class does not take the place of a basic free motion quilting class. You MUST be able to free motion quilt with some comfort and proficiency to take this class - but you need not be perfect!
2. Machine quilting rulers ARE NOT the same as rotary cutting rulers.
3. The Ruler quilting foot IS NOT the same as a free motion/hopping foot. You are responsible for researching and purchasing the correct ruler foot for your machine.

By using the trim-down method, students will continue to build their Lemoyne Star skills making beautiful stars that traditionally are paper pieced. Note that this class is built on skills learned in the Freshman Year session. Experience making Lemoyne Stars using the Studio 180 tool is required.

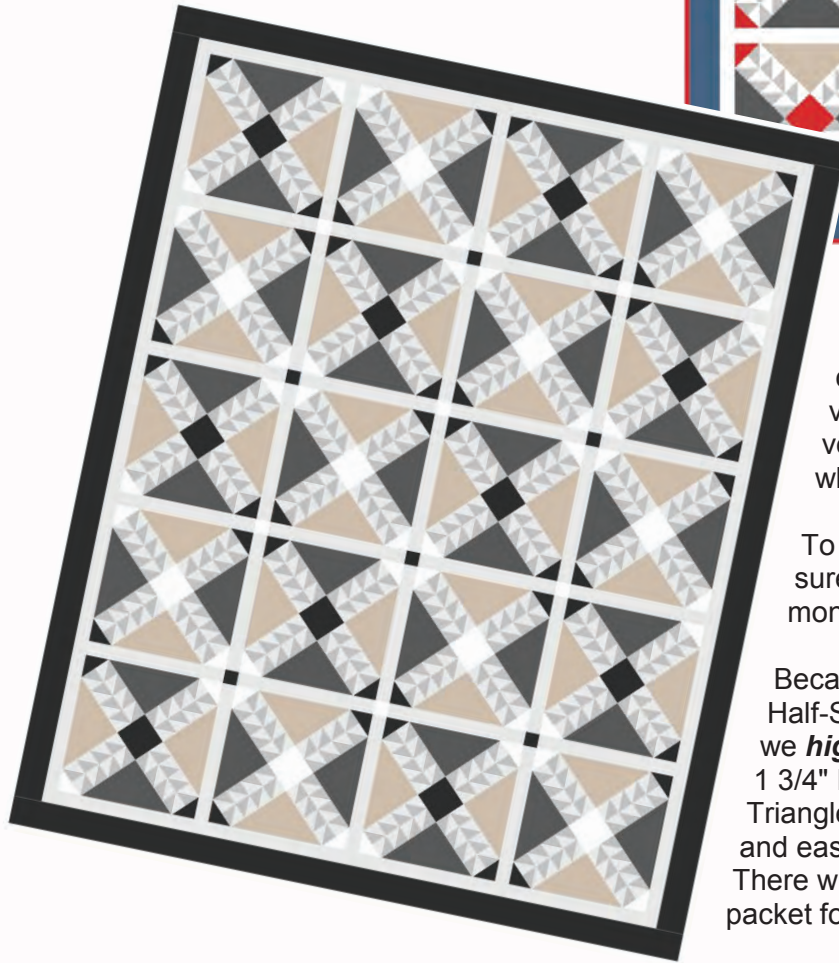
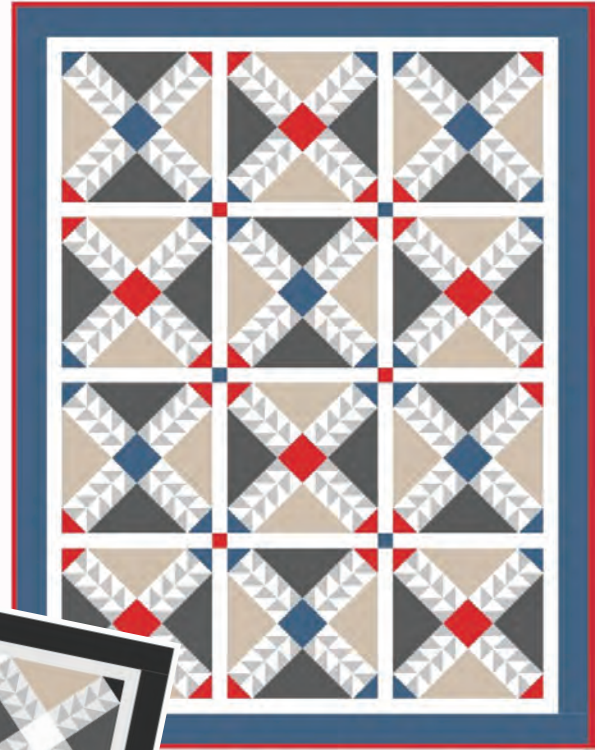
Pick-Up Block of the Month

A Block of the Month Program

Inspired by the Lady of the Lake block, this quilt features scrappy fabrics in a sashed layout. While our 57" x 74" sample showcases 12 blocks, you can choose to make a larger 74" x 90" quilt.

Offered in either Nautical or Batik colorways, this program runs for 6 months. Each monthly packet will include enough fabrics to make 2 blocks with the same color in the center. There will be two center colors used for the whole program.



Red and blue are used for the centers and the corners of the Nautical version while the Batik version will have black and white.

To make the larger quilt, be sure to pick up 2 packets monthly.

Because of the large number of Half-Square Triangles in this quilt, we **highly recommend** using the 1 3/4" Finished Half Square Triangle Paper to make accurate and easy Half Square Triangles. There will be enough fabrics in each packet for this method.

Finishing Directions will be provided at the end of the program.
