Christmas Stocking Supply List and Preparation Sheet

We will be making the stripe or the Bargello pattern in class in the regular size. The student will choose whether to have a cuff or not. The student will receive all the sizes, patterns, and instructions in class.

For class you will need:

Fabric: ½ yard for the back

½ yard for the lining

1 ½ inch strips in light, medium, and dark Christmas fabrics

11 in by 20 in piece (if you want a cuff)

Batting: ½ yard or two pieces 18 inches x 24 inches

Thread: 50-weight thread or a decorative thread with a 60-weight thread for the bobbin

Preparation for before class:

Place the backing fabric (18 in by 24 in) on top of the batting with the wrong side of the fabric touching the batting. Quilt.

Optional: Cut out 1 ½ inch strips of Christmas fabric. The Bargello stocking has 4 shades of red, 3 light, 4 shades of green, 3 light, and 4 shades of red again. About 18 different fabric strips. Do not put these together yet.
