- o **Fabric** for the pants: Adults 21/4 Yd

Teens - 21/4 Yd

Children - 11/2 Yd

Contrasting fabric for the pockets and cuffs - ½ Yd

- Thread to blend in with the fabric
- Non roll elastic (available in shop)
- Bodkin to insert elastic (available in shop)
- o A pair of good **scissors** to cut out
- o **Pins**, seam ripper, marking pen
- Sewing machine

o Cut out the paper pattern. We will cut our pants in the class.
