

Saltwater Sampler Supply List

What you will need on the first day of class:

- Book: **Family Favorites by Sherri McConnell and Chelsi Stratton**
- Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal
- All machine accessories, tools, and ¼ inch presser foot (if you have one), and extra bobbins
- Scissors, pins, seam ripper, small ruler (3 ½ x 6 ½ inches)
- Rotary cutter
- Paper and pen for notes

On the first day of class:

You do not need your fabrics for the first day of class. On the first day of class, we will discuss general quilting terms, a beginning cutting, pressing, and sewing lesson, and a short lesson about color and choosing fabric. Each student will be provided with the pieces for the quilt block being made in class. The student will have the instructions and will remake the block at home in the fabrics of their choosing for their quilt.

What you will need for the Saltwater Sampler Quilt project being done in this class:

5 ½ yards for the background, sashing, cornerstones and border

24 to 25 fat quarters or ¼ yard cuts

½ yard for the block centers

1 yard for the sashing

½ yard for cornerstones
