# Wensleydale Quilt Pattern Paper Piecing

Finished Size: 44"x 58"

Layout: 5 blocks across x 8 blocks down Finished Block Size: 11" x 7 1/4" Fabric Required: 32 Fat Quarters (FQ)

#### **Materials:**

- 32 Fat Quarters (FQs) 16 for Pieces 14–17, 16 for all other pieces
- · Coordinating thread

#### Tools:

- · Rotary cutter and self-healing cutting mat
- Quilting ruler(s)
- · Add a Quarter Ruler
- Glue stick
- Foundation Papers for Wensleydale Jen Kingwell
- Sewing machine with 1/4" presser foot
- · Pins or clips
- · Fabric marking tool

#### **Fabric Selection:**

- 16 Fat Quarters Use these for Pieces 14–17. Cut all eight pieces from a single fat quarter. This will be for two blocks.
- 16 Fat Quarters Use these for all other pieces in the quilt. Each fat quarter will also cut two blocks per fat quarter.

### **Cutting Instructions:**

16 fat quarters for pieces 1 -13 from each FQ on the 22" side of FQ.	Strip segments to sub cut.
Cut 3 strips 2 1/2" x 18"	Sub cut 1 strip into:  • (2) – 2 ½" x 4" for piece #1  • (4) – 2 ½" x 2" for pieces 4-5  Sub cut 2 strips into:  • (8) – 2 ½" x 4 ½" for pieces 6-9
Cut 1 strip 4 1/2" x 18"	Sub cut strip into:  • (4) – 4 ½" x 3 ½" for pieces 10-11
Cut 1 strip 6 1/2" x 18"	Sub cut strip into:  • (4) – 6 ½" x 4 ¼" for pieces 12 -13
Cut 1 strip 1 ½" x 18"	Sub cut strip into:  • (4) – 1 ½" x 3 ½" for pieces 2-3

16 fat quarters for pieces 14 -17 from each FQ on the 22" side of FQ.	Strip segments to sub cut
Cut 2 strips 7 1/4" x 18"	Sub cut each strip into:  • (4) – 7 ¼" x 4 ¼" for pieces 14 -17

## **Tips for Success:**

- · Label pieces as you cut to avoid mixing sizes.
- Group each block's pieces in a small bag or tray for easy assembly.
- Important Cutting Note:

All pieces must be cut across the 22" width of the fat quarter. They will not fit if cut from the 18" side. Be sure to position your ruler so that the measurements runs along the 22" edge of the fabric before cutting. See diagrams on following page.
