Class Supply List

Basic Supplies

Sewing machine with 1/4" foot

Walking foot – makes sewing easier and more accurate

Threads to match your fabrics

Bobbins (please prewind at least 2)

Fabric scissors

Pins

Clover Wonder Clips 15-20 small or large size

Clover Chalk markers or Sew-Line marking pencil

Basting Spray

Metal Zipper End Caps (optional)

See Pictures of Tote below for where fabrics go if you want to be creative with fabrics. Let me know if you would help selecting where fabrics go, remember I work most Wednesdays.

Boxy Tote

*Your choice of fabric:

Materials: Boxy Tote

Fabric A – 1 yard (Outer end pockets, handles and outer bag front and back)

Fabric B - 1 1.3 yard or 1 2/3 yards for directional fabric (Outer bag ends, inner bag ends, outer bag front and back pockets, inner front and back)

Fabric C - 1 yard (Inner end pockets, inner front and back pockets, outer bag end pocket linings, outer bag front and back pocket linings)

Single-sided Light Fusible Fleece – 1 1/4 yards (45" wide)

Soft & Stable Foam - 1/2 yard (58" wide) (they make one sided fusible as well)

Basting Spray

Pletex - Double Sided Fusible Stabilizer - 1/3 yard (20" wide)

30" Separating zipper color coordinated to match fabric. This is quite prominent in the finished bag, so make sure you like the color with your Fabric A.

To ensure that you have a finished bag by the end of class please have the following done BEFORE class:

****Note: I HIGHLY recommend you label each piece with the name and the measurements. Use paper and pin the label to your fabric pieces as you cut them. It makes it much easier during construction. Also, if you have directional fabric(s) pay attention to the measurements, they are all labeled by height and width.****
Be sure to bring all your fabric scraps to class "Just in Case".

Fabric A: Cut 2: 12" wide x 19" tall (Outer Bag Front and Back)

Cut 3: 3 1/2 x 42 (Bag Handles)

Cut 2: 7" wide x 7" tall (Outer Bag End Pockets)

Fabric B: Cut 2: 12 1/2" wide x 12" tall (Outer Bag Front and Back Pockets)

Cut 2: 12: wide x 18" tall (Inner Bag Front and Back

Cut 2: 10" wide x 14" tall (Inner Bag 6Ends)

Cut 2: 10" wide x 15" tall (Outer Bag Ends)

Fabric C: Cut 2: 12 1/2" wide x 10" tall (Outer Bag Front and Back Pocket Linings)

Cut 2: 7" wide x 8" tall (Outer Bag End Pocket Linings)

Cut 2: 12" wide x 14" tall (Inner Front and Back Pockets)

Cut 2: 10" wide x 14" tall (Inner End Pockets)

Single-Sided Fusible Fleece:

Cut 2: 11" wide x 6" tall (Inner Front and Back Pockets)

Cut 2 : 3 1/2" x 39" long (Handles)

Cut 2: 9" wide x 6" tall (Inner End Pockets)

Cut 1: 5" x 5" (Zipper Tabs)

Cut 2: 11 1/2" x 12" tall (Outer Bag Front and Back Pockets)

Cut 2: 6 1/2" wide x 6 1/2" tall (Outer End Pockets)

Soft & Stable:

Cut 1: 12" wide x 37 1/2" long((Outer Bag Front and Back)

Cut 1: 12" wide x 35 1/2 long (Inner Bag front and Back)

Cut 2: 10" wide x 14" tall (Inner Bag Ends)

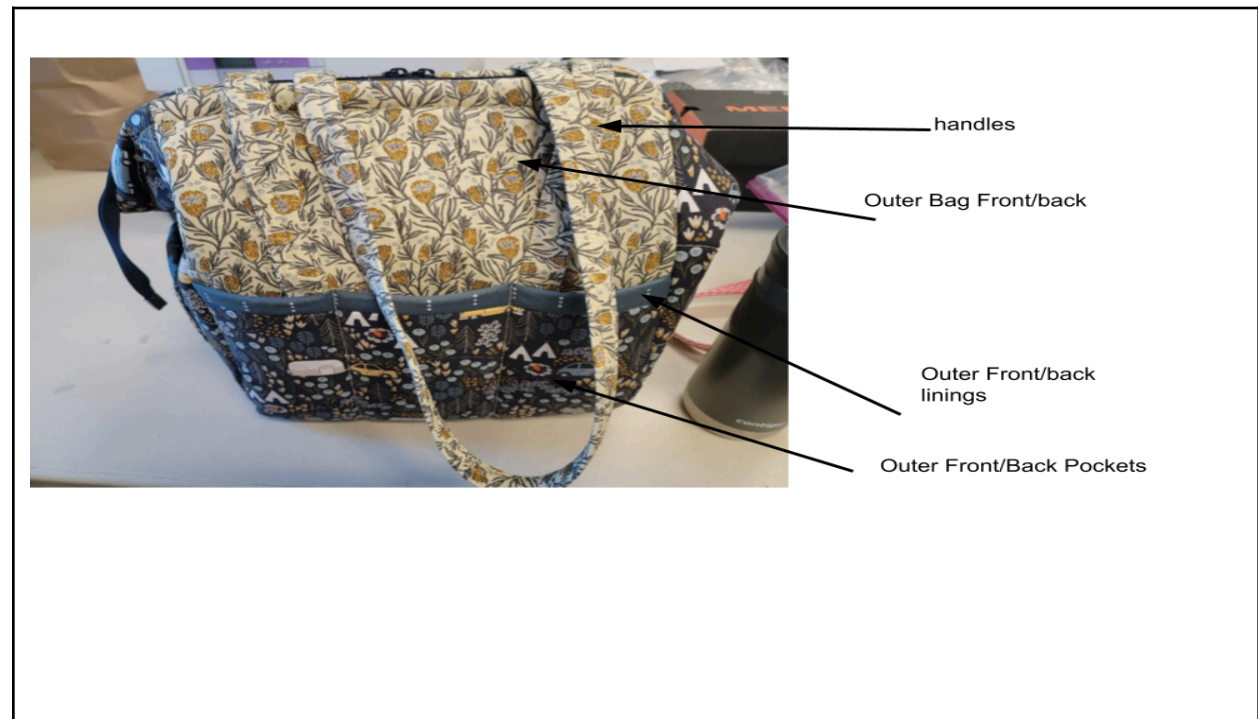
Cut 2: 10" x 15" (Outer Bag Ends)

*Your choice of fabric:

Cut 1: 5" x 5" (Zipper Tabs) **Wait to cut this. I'm working on an alternative for the zipper tabs.**
