Class Supplies:

Aunt Bea's Quilt Pattern (If you want to do the same project as we are working on)

9" squares (one for each design) of light fabric for back ground

12 - 4 inch squares of white fabric interfaced with SF101 interfacing (for stitch practice)

SF 101 for interfacing each square (**after** tracing the pattern)

Light box for tracing

Blue painters tape

.005 or .002 Black Micron Pen (for tracing)

Hoop (if you use one)

Embroidery floss or Sulky 12 wt thread

Hand Embroidery needles

Scissors
