Class: Hot Pocket Travel Iron Holder

Supply List (supplies bought at the shop will be 10% off):

Materials needed:

- For Hot Pocket: Main fabric*: 10"-12" wide; 27" long
 - Directional fabrics are not recommended.
 - You can create your own fabric from scraps or precuts or orphan blocks. Just be sure that your fabric measures *at least* 10" wide x 27" long. The shop sample was created using part of a charm pack, and the raw measurements were 10 ½" x 27".
- For Hot Pocket, EITHER
 - Pre-quilted ironing board fabric, same size as main fabric, OR
 - Insul-Bright® AND silver ironing board fabric, each measuring the same size as main fabric (please contact the instructor if you are having a hard time sourcing this, or with any questions)
- For cord holder: Junk fabric or muslin (you will not see it): 9" x 10" and
- For cord holder, EITHER
 - Pre-quilted ironing board fabric, 9" x 10", OR
 - Insul-Bright® AND silver ironing board fabric, each measuring 9" x 10"
- Two pieces of 1/8" elastic, each measuring 2 ½" long, OR two metal snaps (plastic snaps are not recommended). The instructor will have several colors of 1/8" elastic on hand if needed.
- Two large shank buttons if you use elastic loops, with hand sewing needle and thread
- For Insul-Bright/silver fabric option, you will need quilt basting spray

- Frixion marker* or pen*
- Thread* to match main fabric
- Gray* thread
- 100/16 sewing machine needles* recommended
- Pins* and Wonder Clips®*
- Stiletto or chopstick or Purple Thang®*
- Iron and ironing surface (shop ironing board will be available)
- Scissors, rotary cutter, mat, rotary ruler, and the rest of your basic sewing supplies
