**Class:** QAYG Placemat

**Supply List** (supplies bought at the shop will be 10% off):

**\*\*\*Please read through this entire list and the additional comments!\*\*\***

Join Jane for this three hour, beginner friendly class to quickly whip up placemats. We will use the Quilt As You Go (QAYG) technique. If you can sew a straight line, you will be successful. When you are done sewing, all you do is add binding, and you are done! This is super scrap friendly; you can also use jelly rolls.

**Before you attend class, please note:**

- Gather materials as noted below

**Things to bring to class:**

- An open mind and your creativity!
- Fabric:
  - 13" x 18" (or desired size) piece of fabric for *each* placemat (backing)
  - same size of batting or fusible fleece or Insul-Bright (use one or two layers) for each placemat

- basting spray, if desired, if using batting or Insul-Bright
- total of 150" or more of 2 ½" strips. The chevron sample was made with three strips each of three fabrics which were each 18" wide.
- for other designs, you may wish to start with a 5" block. Bring extra fabric so you can play.
- Alternately, you can bring a ton of scraps for a really scrappy finished product
- extra strips of 2 ¼" or 2 ½" fabric for binding; total of 72" for each placemat
- Pins\* and/or fabric glue stick\* if you have one- this should be Sewline or Bohin thin fabric glue stick, not the XL size that looks like a kid's giant glue stick
- Thread which blends with fabric strips
- Sewing machine with size 14 needle and standard foot
- Walking foot or dual feed foot
- Pre-wound bobbin with thread which matches backing fabric
- Scissors\* for cutting fabric and trimming threads
- Rotary cutter\*, rotary cutting ruler\* and rotary cutting mat
- Travel iron and pressing mat\*. NOTE: This is a sew-press-sew-press project. PLEASE bring a travel iron if you have one, or we will be taking turns at the ironing board! See *ADDITIONAL COMMENTS below.*
- Seam ripper\*
- Frixion pen or marker

**Pre-work to be completed before class:** Just assemble all of your materials!

**Additional comments:**

- The instructor has travel irons for sale (\$5 each). Please let her know ahead of time if you would like one.
