Class: Log Cabin Chicken

Date/Time: September 26, 2026, 10:30-3, with a break for lunch

Instructor: Jane Beamish

Supply List (supplies bought at the shop will be 10% off):

1. Foundation(s) will be provided to you as part of the class
2. Fabric, cut to size:
 - a. An assortment of light and dark fabrics as follows:
 Note: only the first square needs to be cut to the exact size. You may wish to bring a bunch of 1 ½" strips of fabric and cut as you go.

Light	Placement	Dark	Placement
1 ½" square	2	1 ½" square (you may wish to make this one red)	1
1 ½" x 2 ½"	3	1 ½" x 2 ½"	4
1 ½" x 3 ¼"	6	1 ½" x 3 ¼"	5
1 ½" x 4 ¼"	7	1 ½" x 4 ¼"	8
1 ½" x 5"	10	1 ½" x 5"	9
1 ½" x 6"	11	1 ½" x 6"	12
		1 ½" x 7 ¼"	13

- b. Tail: one, two, or three squares of fabric:
 - i. 3 ¼" square

- ii. (optional) 3" square
 - iii. (optional) 2 ½" square
 - c. Comb: 2" x 3" red, can be cotton, wool, or felt
 - d. Beak: 1 ½" square
3. Flat headed pins* and/or fabric glue stick*. If you have the fabric glue stick, it should be the thin Sewline or Bohin one, not the one that looks like a kid's XL school glue stick.
 4. Regular pins and Wonder Clips
 5. Add-a-Quarter ruler*- 6" size is best for this project.
 6. Thread* (suggested beige)
 7. Sewing machine with size 14 needle and open-toe foot
 8. Pre-wound bobbin- beige is good, or a color that blends in with your fabrics
 9. Scissors* for trimming threads
 10. Rotary cutter*, rotary cutting ruler* and rotary cutting mat
 11. Something to press with- fingers, wallpaper seam roller, and, if you have them, travel/mini iron and pressing surface. The instructor will have a couple of travel irons for purchase if you need one (\$5).
 12. Seam ripper*
 13. Pencil (**not** a Frixion pen)

After the class, you will need:

1. Two small buttons or a permanent pen for the eyes
2. Stuffing; walnut shells and/or fluffy stuffing
3. Hand needle for sewing up closure

PLEASE NOTE:

- Class will start **at** the designated time.
- You are welcome to come to the shoppe early to purchase items, set up your machine, etc. Be sure you have bobbins and thread ready to go!
- Sewing machine stitch length should be set at 1.5-1.8 for digital or around 15-20 stitches per inch if you don't have a digital machine.
- Please bring your manual if you are unfamiliar with your machine.

Pre-work to be completed before class:

- Assemble supplies
- Cut log cabin fabrics into 1 ½" strips
