**Class Supplies** (supplies bought at the shop will be 10% off):

1. Foundations printed on foundation paper will be provided for you
2. Fabric, cut to size:

Label pieces with a Frixion pen or marker on the wrong side, use post-it flags or scrap paper, or clip with numbered mini clothespins

A1	1 ½" x 2"	Brown (stem)
A2	1 ¾" x 2 ½"	Black/background
A3	1 ¾" x 2"	Black/background
A4	2" x 3"	Orange/pumpkin
A5	2 ¾" x 5 ¼"	Black/background
A6	3" x 5 ½"	Black/background
B1	2 ¾" x 3 ¾"	Orange/Pumpkin
B2	1 ½" x 2 ½"	Orange/Pumpkin
B3	2 ½" x 2 ¾"	Orange/Pumpkin
B4	2" x 6"	Orange/Pumpkin

B5	2 ¼" x 6"	Orange/Pumpkin
B6	1 ½" x 2 ½"	Orange/Pumpkin
B7	2 ¼" x 4 ¾"	Orange/Pumpkin
B8	1 ¾" x 6"	Orange/Pumpkin
B9	1 ½" x 4 ¼"	Orange/Pumpkin
B10	1 ½" x 3 ½"	Orange/Pumpkin
B11 and B12	1 ¼" x 2" (cut 2)	Black/Background
B13	1 ¼" x 5"	Black/Background
B14	1 ¼" x 6"	Black/Background
B15	1 ¼" x 8"	Black/Background
Optional borders	1 ½" x 7 ½" (cut 2)	Any border fabric you like
	1 ½" x 8 ½" (cut 2)	

\*NOTE: If you don't like quarter inch measurements, please cut larger. For example, you can cut B7 at 2"x 5" rather than 2" x 4 ¾".

3. Flat headed pins\* and/or fabric glue stick\*. If you have the fabric glue stick, it should be the thin Sewline or Bohin one, not the one that looks like a kid's XL school glue stick.
4. Add-a-Quarter ruler\*- 6" or 12" size will work.
5. A postcard; the instructor can provide one if you do not have one
6. Thread\* (suggested grey or orange)
7. Sewing machine with size 14 needle and open-toe foot (bring all of the presser feet if you aren't sure what is what)
8. Pre-wound bobbin- grey is good, or a color that blends in with your fabrics
9. Scissors\* for trimming threads
10. Scissors\* that you can use to cut paper
11. Rotary cutter\*, rotary cutting ruler\* and rotary cutting mat
12. Something to press with- fingers, wallpaper seam roller, and, if you have them, travel/mini iron and pressing surface. The instructor will have a couple of travel irons for purchase if you need one (\$5).
13. Seam ripper\*
14. Pencil (**not** a Frixion pen)

- You are welcome to come to the shoppe early to purchase items, set up your machine, etc. Be sure you have bobbins and thread ready to go!
