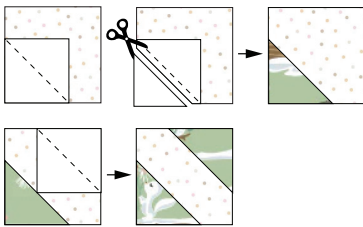




Baubles by Sewlarium

Due to the number of pieces in this block, I have found that it is easiest to sew with a very scant seam allowance (3/16") and trim down extra along the way. Press your seam allowances as you go.



Gather the 1.5" low volume square piece and two of the 1" Frosty squares. Stitch and Flip the corners: Mark a diagonal line on the back of the 1" squares. Place pieces right sides together, aligning the bottom left corner and sew along your marked line. Trim off the excess, and press. Repeat the process with the upper right corner. This is the bauble's glint.



Sew the 2" x 1.5" piece of Frosty fabric to the left of the glint and the 1" x 1.5" piece to the right. Next sew the 3.5" x 1" piece to the top and the 3.5" square to the bottom.

Stitch and flip the corners of the completed piece using the 1.5" squares of snowflake fabric on top corners and the 1.75" squares on the bottom corners.

Sew the 1" x 1.5" brown piece in between the two 1" x 1.5" snowflake pieces along the short edges and sew to the top of the bauble.



Sew the 1" x 3.5" snowflake pieces to the top and bottom.

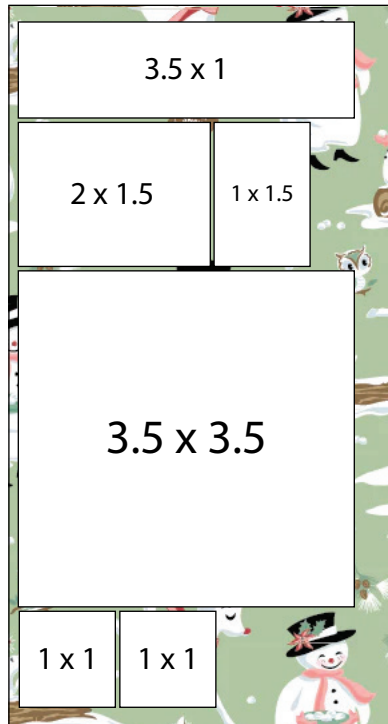
Finally, sew the 2" x 6.5" pieces to the right and left.

Press and trim to a 6.5" square.

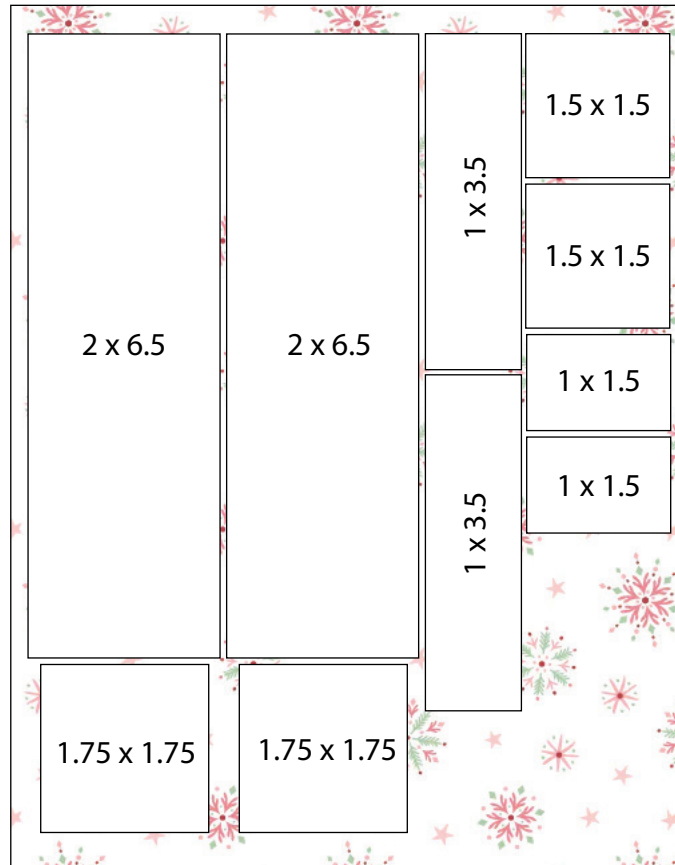

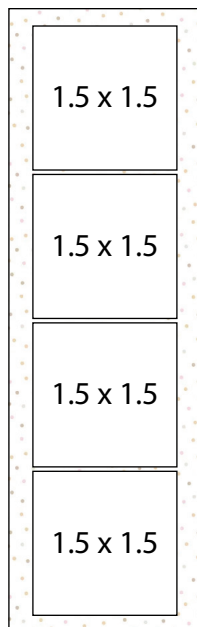
Frosty:



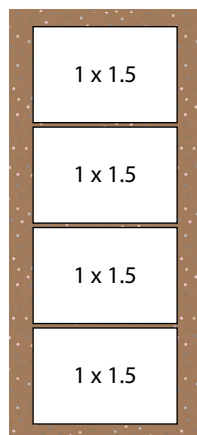
Snow Flake:



Low volume:

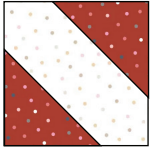

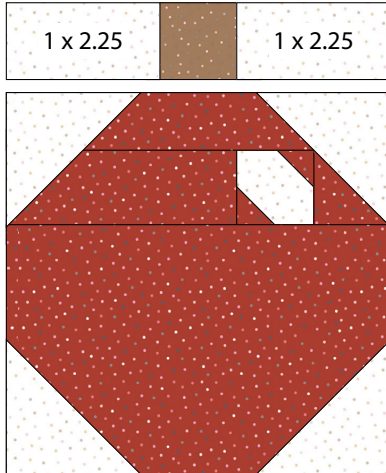
You'll have left over brown and low volume pieces if you only make the 6-inch block!

Repeat the first page to make a second bauble with the Frosty and Snowflake fabrics.



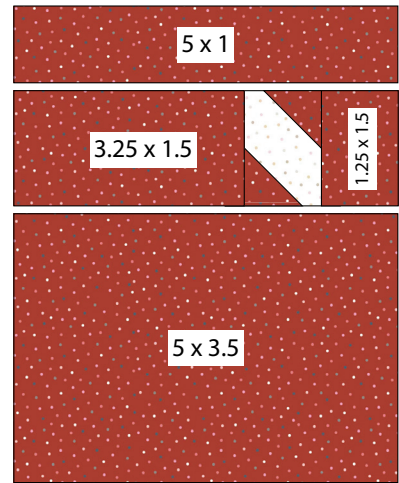
Make a glint the same way you did on the previous block, this time using the 1-inch squares of red fabric.

Sew the glint into the red bauble the same as before:



Stitch and flip all four corners using the 1.75" squares of low volume fabric.

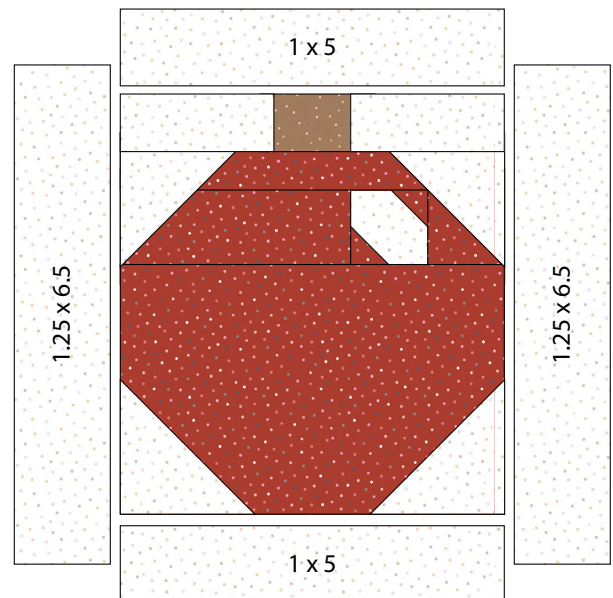
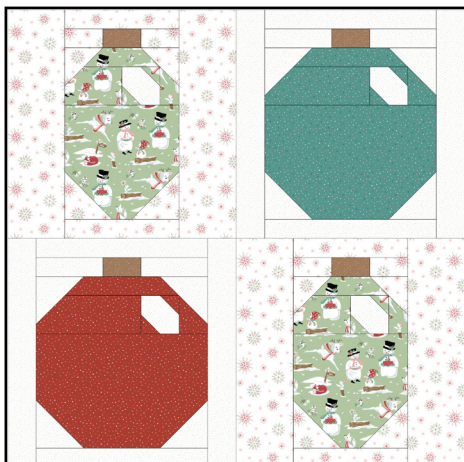
Sew a brown piece, along the short edges, between the two 1" x 2.25" low volume pieces and attach to the top of the bauble.



Sew the top and bottom borders on followed by the left and right.

Press and trim to a 6.5" square.

Repeat these steps to make a green bauble.



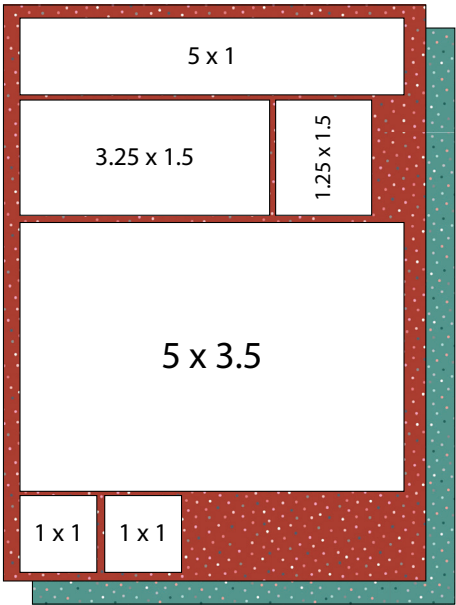
Sew your 4 baubles together into the finished 12.5" block!
