Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut one 22 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle centered on the design. (**Quilt Center**)

Fabric B:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut seventy-two 2" squares. (**Button Backgrounds**)
- Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut ninety-six 2 1/2" squares. (**Button Backgrounds**)
- Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut twenty-four 4 1/2" squares. (**Button Backgrounds**)

Fabric C:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric D:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric E:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric F:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric G:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric H:

- Cut one 4 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 8" rectangles and four 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut four 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

- Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)
- Cut one 1 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut six 1 1/2" x 2" rectangles. (**Button Blocks**)

Fabric I:

- Cut two 5 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips. (**Inner Border**)
- Cut two 4 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips. (**Inner Border**)

Fabric J:

- Cut (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips. (**Outer Border**)
- Cut (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Trim seams to 1/4" and press open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips. (**Outer Border**)

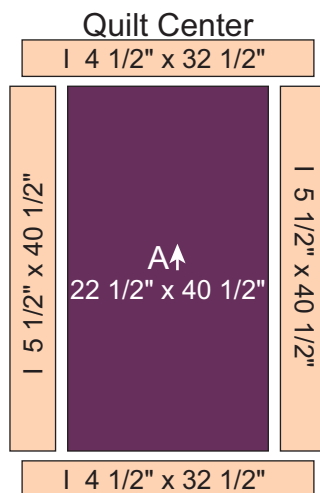
Binding:

- Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew one 5 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 40 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew one 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" **Fabric I** strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the 32 1/2" x 48 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 1)



Make (1) = 32 1/2" x 48 1/2" unfinished

2. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric B** square at the top of one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 2) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right

corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 2) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 3) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

3. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric B** square at the bottom of the 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 4) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 4) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 1 rectangle. (Diagram 5)
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make an additional three Unit 1 rectangles.

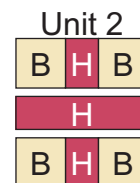

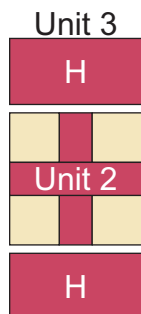
Make (4) = 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished

5. Sew one 2" **Fabric B** square to each side of one 1 1/2" x 2" **Fabric H** rectangle. Repeat to make a second rectangle. Sew one newly sewn rectangle to the top and bottom of one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to make one 4 1/2" Unit 2 square. (Diagram 6) Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.



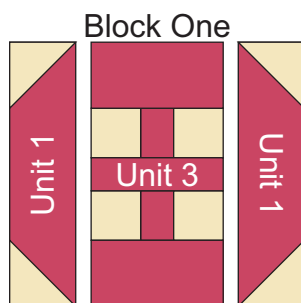
Make (2) = 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished

6. Sew one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangle to the top and bottom of one Unit 2 square to make one 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 3 rectangle. (Diagram 7) Repeat to make a second Unit 3 rectangle.



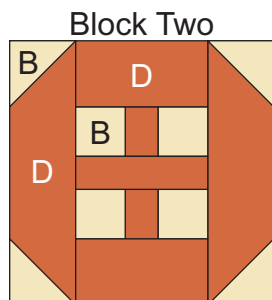
Make (2) = 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished

7. Sew one Unit 1 rectangle to each side of one Unit 3 rectangle to make one 8 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 8) Repeat to make a second Block One square.

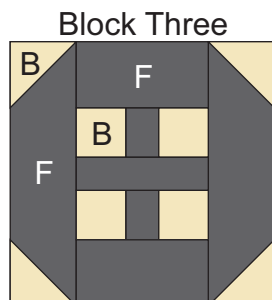

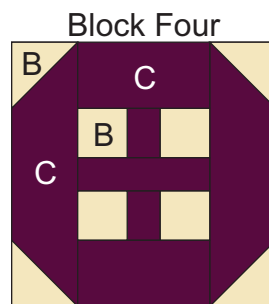
8. Repeat Steps 2-7 and refer to Diagrams 9-13 for fabric identification and placement to make two of each 8 1/2" block square for Block Two through Block Six.



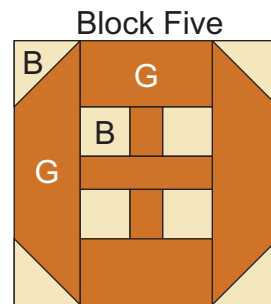

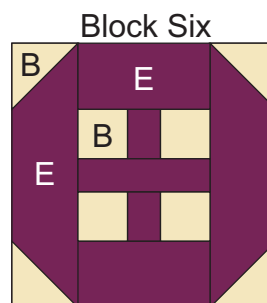

9. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric B** square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 14) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 14) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 15) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

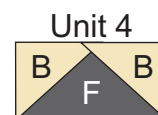

10. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric B** square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 16) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 16) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 4 rectangle. (Diagram 17)
11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make an additional three Unit 4 rectangles.

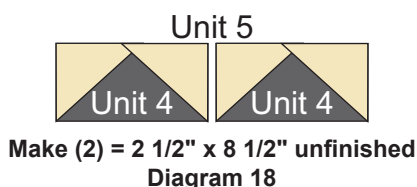

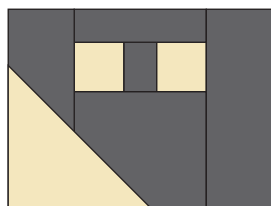
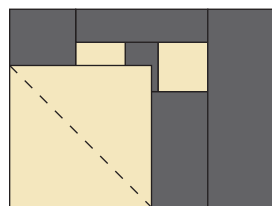
12. Sew together two Unit 4 rectangles end to end to make one $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ Unit 5 rectangle. (Diagram 18) Repeat to make a second Unit 5 rectangle.



13. Sew one 2" **Fabric B** square to each side of one $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$ **Fabric F** rectangle. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric F** rectangle to the top and one $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 4"$ **Fabric F** rectangle to the bottom of the newly sewn rectangle to make one $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ Unit 6 rectangle. (Diagram 19) Repeat to make a second Unit 6 rectangle.
14. Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric F** rectangle to each side of Unit 6 rectangle to make one $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ Unit 7 rectangle. (Diagram 20) Repeat to make a second Unit 7 rectangle.



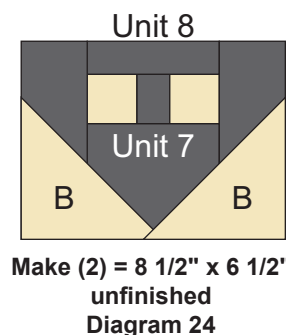
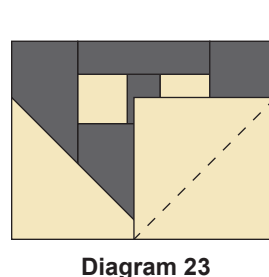
15. Place one $4\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric B** square on the lower left corner of one Unit 7 rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 21) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 21) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 22) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance.



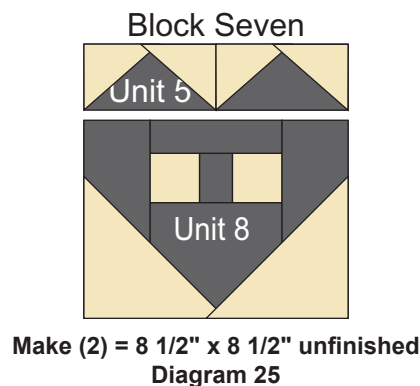
16. Place one $4\frac{1}{2}"$ **Fabric B** square on the lower right corner of the Unit 7 rectangle, right sides

together. (Diagram 23) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. (Diagram 23) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance to make one $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ Unit 8 rectangle. (Diagram 24)

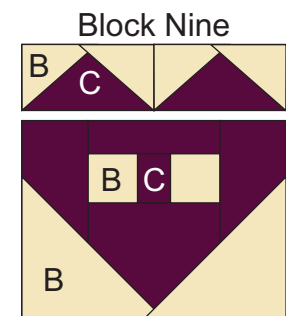
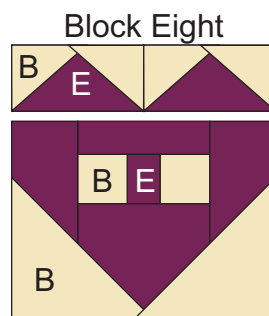
17. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make a second Unit 8 rectangle.

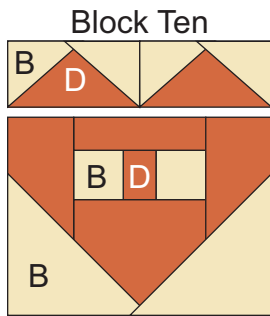


18. Sew one Unit 5 rectangle to the top of one Unit 8 rectangle to make one $8\frac{1}{2}"$ Block Seven square. (Diagram 25) Repeat to make a second Block Seven square.

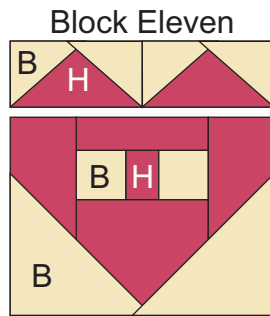


19. Repeat Steps 9-18 and refer to Diagrams 26-30 for fabric identification and placement to make two of each $8\frac{1}{2}"$ block square for Block Eight through Block Twelve.

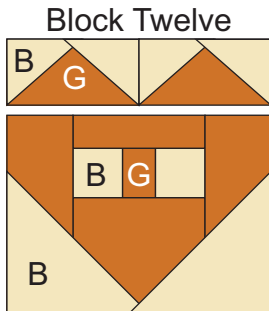

one Block Four square, one Block Ten square and one Block Six square, in that order from left to right, to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Bottom Border to the bottom of the Quilt Center.

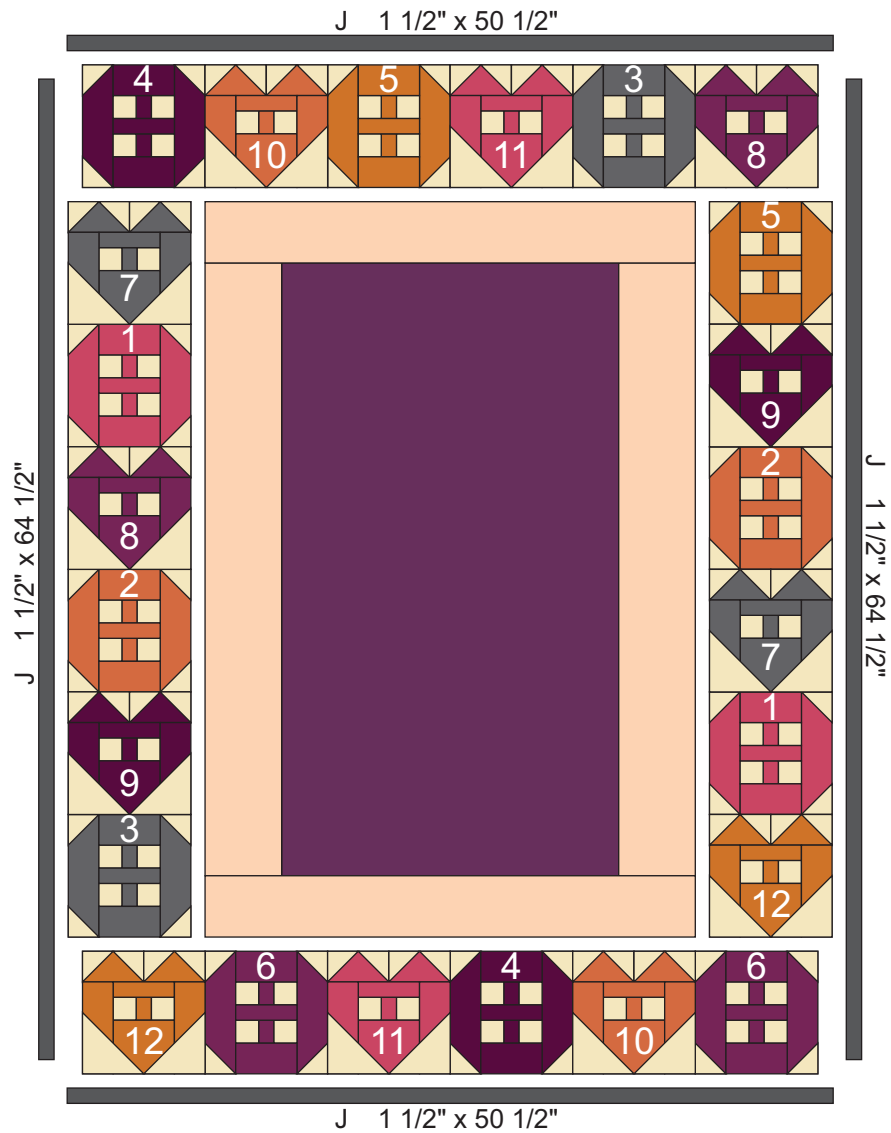
24. Sew one 1 1/2" x 64 1/2" **Fabric J** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" **Fabric J** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top.

Finishing:

25. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim to 58" x 74".
26. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
27. Quilt as desired.
28. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
29. Attach 2 1/2" binding strips using your favorite method.

Quilt Assembly:

20. Sew together one Block Seven square, one Block One square, one Block Eight square, one Block Two square, one Block Nine square and one Block Three square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border. Sew the Left Side Border to the left side of the Quilt Center.
21. Sew together one Block Five square, one Block Nine square, one Block Two square, one Block Seven square, one Block One square and one Block Twelve square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border. Sew the Right Side Border to the right side of the Quilt Center.
22. Sew together one Block Four square, one Block Ten square, one Block Five square, one Block Eleven square, one Block Three square and one Block Eight square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border. Sew the Top Border to the top of the Quilt Center.
23. Sew together one Block Twelve square, one Block Six square, one Block Eleven square,
