QUILT BLOCK INSTRUCTIONS

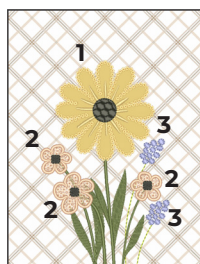
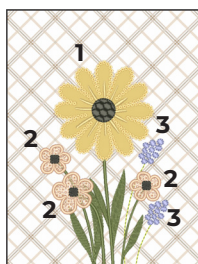
October Block

Make 2 blocks.

This block is made in **(2)** parts:

Part A is stitching the dimensional lace flowers.

Part B is making the rest of the block.



Note: The materials listed below are for **(1)** block.

Part B

Fabric 1: Background

(1) 8½ x 10½"

Fabric 2: Flower 1*

(1) 4 x 4"

*An SVG file is provided.

Wash-Away Stabilizer



Part B Stabilizer

(Additional stabilizers are listed in Part B.)

Fusible Backing



• Iron **Fusible Backing** to the **wrong side** of the Background Fabric.

Embroidery Thread Colors

Charcoal* Dark Green Blue-Purple
Peach Light Green Yellow

Background Quilting Thread Color: Cream*

*Not included in the Glide thread kit.

Part A Hooping Instructions

- Cut **(2)** sheets of **Wash-Away Stabilizer** larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Hoop **(2)** sheets of stabilizer only.
- Go to the Part A Embroidery Instructions.

Part A Embroidery Instructions

Embroidery File

4x4-october-part-a



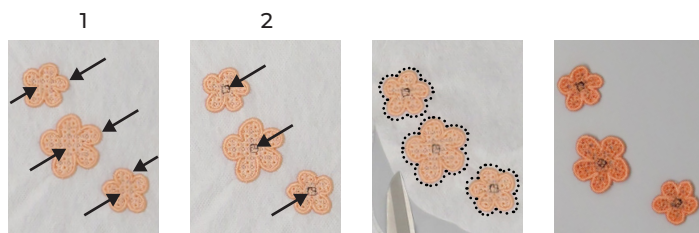
4x4:

2.59 x 3.00" or 65.9 x 76.3 mm

5,266 stitches



- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- 1. **Change the bobbin thread to match the top thread.** Stitch the Lace Mesh and Satin Outlines.
- 2. **Change the bobbin thread to match the top thread.** Stitch the Placement Lines.
- **Change the bobbin thread back to a neutral color.** Remove the project from the hoop. Trim the excess stabilizer around the project pieces.
- Rinse the project in cool water to dissolve any remaining stabilizer. Lay flat to dry.
- You now have **(1)** Large Flower 2 and **(2)** Small Flowers 2 pieces. Set aside for later use.
- Go to Part B.



Part B Option 1: Block-By-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer** only.

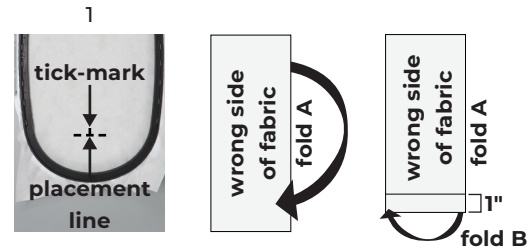
⚠ Special Alignment:

- Align the block embroidery file with the **bottom** of the quilting design.
- Refer to the Block-by-Block Quilting Instructions on pages 9–10 in the **Tips and Tricks** PDF. Design and alignment information are listed above.
- **To quilt with a 5x7 or smaller hoop**, refer to the Quilting Blocks in a 5x7 Hoop Instructions on page 11 in the **Tips and Tricks** PDF.
- After quilting, go to the Part B Embroidery Instructions.

Note: If doing block-by-block quilting, skip to **Machine Step 3**.

Note: The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Both hooping options can be made using these instructions.

1. In a visible thread color, stitch the Background Placement Line and Tick-mark directly onto the stabilizer.
 - Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Fold the Background Fabric in half **lengthwise, right sides together**. Finger press along the fold. This is fold A.
- Fold the bottom **short edge** up 1". Finger press along the fold. This is fold B.



- Align fold A with the tick-mark and fold B with the placement line as shown.
- Unfold and smooth the fabric. Tape in place.

Part B Option 2: Hooping Instructions

(Refer to page 7 in the **Tips and Tricks** PDF.)

Placement Line Hooping:

- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away Stabilizer** larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Hoop the stabilizer only.
- Go to the Part B Embroidery Instructions.

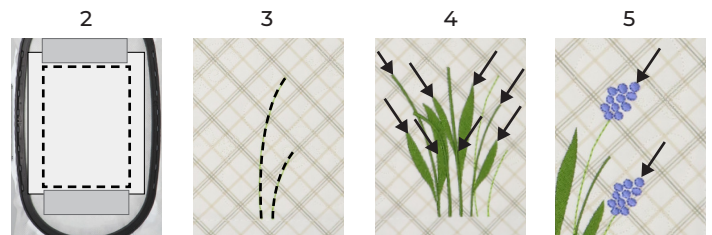

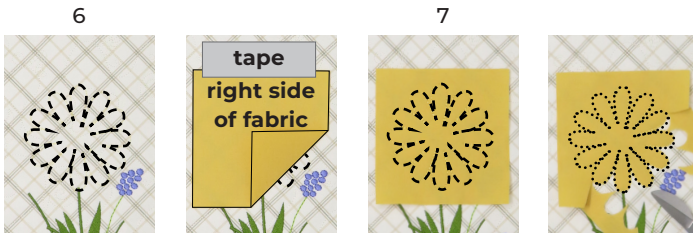

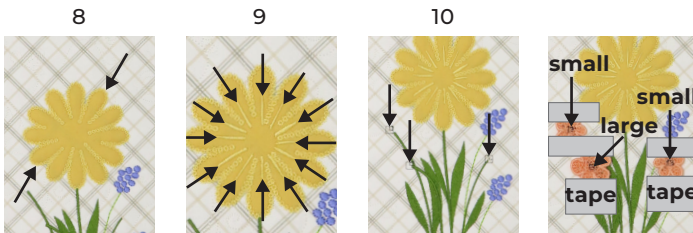
2. Stitch the Background Basting Line.
 - Carefully remove the tape.
3. Stitch the Light Stems Details.
4. Stitch the Dark Leaves and Stems Fills.
5. Stitch the Flowers 3 Fills.



- ◆ 6. Stitch the Flower 1 Placement Line.
 - Place the Flower 1 Fabric, **right side up**.
- ◆ 7. Stitch the Flower 1 Tack-down Line.
 - Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.



- ◆ 8. Stitch the Flower 1 Decorative Outline.
- ◆ 9. Stitch the Flower 1 Details.
- 10. Stitch the Flowers 2 Placement Lines.
 - Place the **(1)** Large Flower 2 and the **(2)** Small Flowers 2 (stitched in **Part A**) as shown, aligning the placement lines on the flowers with the placement lines on the block. Tape the edges of the flowers in place as shown.



- 11. Stitch the Flowers 2 Tack-down Lines/Centers Fills.
 - Remove the tape.
 - Using a seam ripper, remove the Background Basting Line stitched in **Part B, Machine Step 2**.
 - Note: Skip this step if doing block-by-block quilting.**
 - Remove the block from the hoop.



Trimming Instructions

(Refer to page 8 in the **Tips and Tricks** PDF.)

- Place a 6½ x 8½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Center the design **horizontally**, with the bottom of the stems **aligned with the inner bottom** edge of the ruler.
- Square the block to 6½ x 8½".

· **Note:** The bottom of the stems will be sewn into the seams.
