Block Instructions

August Block

Make 1 block.

Materials listed below are for (1) block.

Fabric: Background	(1) 10½ x 8½"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer*	
Fusible Backing  • Iron to the wrong side of the Background Fabric.	

*Additional stabilizers are listed below.



Embroidery File

5x7-august

5x7: 4.46 x 6.31" or 113.3 x 160.3 mm

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away** stabilizer only.

Design

A kdq667-christmas-17, 6x8 design
6.50 x 8.50" or 165.1 x 215.9 mm

Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



Option 2: Traditional Quilting

(Refer to the **Guide**.)

Traditional Hooping:

- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away** stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

Note: The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method.
Use these instructions for both hooping options.

Embroidery Instructions



1.

J Stitch the Greenery A Fills and Details.

I Stitch the Greenery B Details.

I Change the bobbin thread to a water-soluble bobbin thread or a visible thread color. Stitch the Greenery C Fringe.

E Change the bobbin thread back to a neutral color. Stitch the Greenery C Fringe Tack-down Lines.



• Turn the hoop to the **back**. Remove the fringe bobbin thread as follows:

- **If water-soluble bobbin thread was used:** Spray the fringe stitches with water to dissolve the bobbin thread. **Immediately** use a cotton swab or your fingernails to rub the threads. You should see small thread loops popping up. Continue with the next step. Do not allow the project to dry at this time.
- **If a visible-colored bobbin thread was used:** Use snips or a seam ripper to clip the visible bobbin thread from **Step 3**. **Do not clip any neutral-colored bobbin thread;** these stitches hold the fringe in place.



• Turn the hoop to the **front**. Use tweezers to carefully lift the fringe stitches up and away from the tack-down stitches. This will form the fringe.

• If water-soluble bobbin thread was used, allow the project to dry before continuing.

Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the [Guide](#).)

- Place a 6½ x 8½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to 8½ x 6½".

Optional Block-by-Block Quilting

Filler Blocks 13, 22, and 23

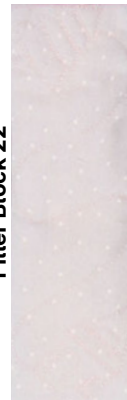
Make 1 of each filler block.

Fabric 1: Filler Block 13 Filler Block 22	(1) 3 x 7" (1) 3 x 7"
Fabric 2: Filler Block 23	(1) 5 x 3"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Project Batting	
Fusible Backing  • Iron to the wrong side of all fabric pieces.

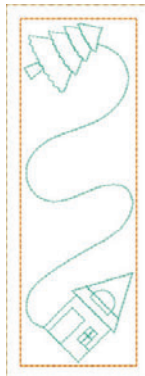

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Quilting Instructions

For more information on quilting the filler blocks, refer to the “Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)” section in the **Guide**. Use the following quilting designs.

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
K Block 13	kdq666-winter-10, 2x6 design	2.50 x 6.50" or 63.5 x 165.1 mm
K Block 22	kdq666-winter-10, 2x6 design	2.50 x 6.50" or 63.5 x 165.1 mm
I Block 23	kdq668-bows-2, 2x4 vertical design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm

After quilting, trim each quilted filler block to the Standard Size listed below.

Filler Block	Trim to Standard Size
Block 13	2½ x 6½"
Block 22	2½ x 6½"
Block 23	4½ x 2½"
