Block Instructions

February Block

Make 2 blocks.

Materials listed below are for (2) blocks.

Fabric 1: Background	(2) 8½ x 8½"
Fabric 2: Stripe	(2) 3½ x 2"
Silver Applique Glitter: Bell	(2) 4½ x 3½"
Red Knit Fabric: Bow	(2) 4½ x 4½"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Fusible Backing	
 • Iron to the wrong side of the Background Fabric and the Bow Knit Fabric.	



Embroidery File

5x7-february

5x7: 3.49 x 3.91" or 88.6 x 99.3 mm

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

• Hoop the stabilizer only.

Design

A kdq667-christmas-17, 6x6 design
6.50 x 6.50" or 165.1 x 165.1 mm

Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



Option 2: Traditional Quilting

(Refer to the **Guide**.)

Traditional Hooping:


- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

Note: The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Use these instructions for both hooping options.


Embroidery Instructions




• Peel the plastic film from the glitter.



1. Stitch the Bell Placement Line.




• Place the Bell Glitter, **right side up**. Tape in place.



2. Stitch the Bell Tack-down Line. Remove the tape.



• Trim the glitter close to the stitch line. Press the glitter with a pressing cloth for 15–20 seconds to adhere.

B Stitch the Bow Placement Line.



• Place the Bow Knit Fabric, **right side up**.

Note: This fabric is **directional**. The lines in the fabric run **vertically** from the **top** to the **bottom** of the hoop.

B Stitch the Bow Tack-down Line.



• Trim the knit fabric close to the stitch line.

B Stitch the Bell Satin Outlines.



6.
J Stitch the Stripe Placement Line.

• Place the Stripe Fabric, **right side up**.

7.
J Stitch the Stripe Tack-down Line.

• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.

8.
J Stitch the Stripe Decorative Outline.



N Stitch the Bow Satin Outlines and Details.



• Remove the block from the hoop.
• Repeat these instructions to make a total of **(2)** blocks.

Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the **Guide**.)

- Place a 6½ x 6½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to 6½ x 6½".

Note: The Jingle Bell will be added later, in the last month of the project.



Filler Block Instructions

Pieced Filler Blocks 9, 16, and 18

Make 1 of each pieced filler block.

Fabric 1: Filler Block 9, Piece 1 Filler Block 18, Piece 2	(1) 3½ x 3" (1) 3½ x 3"
Fabric 2: Filler Block 9, Piece 2 Filler Block 16, Piece 1	(1) 3½ x 3" (1) 3½ x 3"
Fabric 3: Filler Block 16, Piece 2	(1) 3½ x 3"
Fabric 4: Filler Block 18, Piece 1	(1) 3½ x 3"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Project Batting*	
Fusible Backing	
• Iron to the wrong side of the Fabric 2 pieces.	

*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

Note: Use a mini iron or finger press along the seam lines. If you are using an iron, remove the hoop from the machine and press on an ironing board.



Filler Block 9



A White 10000	L Taffy 71775*
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
*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the stabilizer only.

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
A Block 9	kdq667-christmas-17, 2x4 design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm
L Block 16	kdq667-christmas-17, 2x4 design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm
L Block 18	kdq667-christmas-17, 2x4 design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm



Centered Alignment:


- Align the block embroidery file with the quilting design file so that both files are centered.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Pieced Blocks" section in the [Guide](#).
- After placing the batting and trimming, go to the Embroidery Instructions.


Option 2: Traditional Quilting

- Cut the stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Hoop the stabilizer only.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

Note: the photos in these instructions feature the Traditional Quilting Method and Filler Block 9. Use these instructions for both hooping options and all **(3)** filler blocks.

Embroidery Instructions

1.  **A** Stitch the Piecing Template.

 **A** Place Piece 1, **right side up**, covering Section 1.

2. 

A Stitch the Trimming/ Placement Line.



• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.



• Place Piece 2, **right side down**, with one short edge centered along the stitch line.

3. 

A Stitch the Seam.



• Flip the fabric **right side up** and press the seam.

4. 

A Stitch the Trimming Line.


5. 

A If doing the optional block-by-block quilting, stitch the quilting design on **top**.



• Remove the block from the hoop. Repeat these instructions **(2)** more times for **Filler Block 16** and for **Filler Block 18**.

Trimming Instructions



- Using the trimming line as a guide, square each block to $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ ".
