### Quilting Options

#### Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away** stabilizer only.

#### Design

**A** kdq666-winter-10, 6x8 design  
6.50 x 8.50" or 165.1 x 215.9 mm

#### Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.



- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.

#### Option 2: Traditional Quilting





#### Traditional Hooping:

- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away** stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

**Note:** The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Use these instructions for both hooping options.





### Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the **Guide**.)

- Place a 6½ x 8½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to 6½ x 8½".

**Note:** The Ribbon and the Rhinestones will be added later, in the last month of the project.







### Quilting Instructions

For more information on quilting the filler blocks, refer to the “Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)” section in the **Guide**. Use the following quilting designs.

| Filler Block     | Quilting Design                      | Embroidery Field               |
|------------------|--------------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| <b>J</b> Block 2 | kdq668-bows-2, 2x2 horizontal design | 2.50 x 2.50" or 63.5 x 63.5 mm |
| <b>L</b> Block 6 | kdq668-bows-2, 2x2 horizontal design | 2.50 x 2.50" or 63.5 x 63.5 mm |
| <b>L</b> Block 7 | kdq668-bows-2, 2x2 horizontal design | 2.50 x 2.50" or 63.5 x 63.5 mm |



**After** quilting, trim each quilted filler block to the Standard Size listed below.

| Filler Block | Trim to Standard Size |
|--------------|-----------------------|
| Block 2      | 2½ x 2½"              |
| Block 6      | 2½ x 2½"              |
| Block 7      | 2½ x 2½"              |
