# Block Instructions

## July Block

Make 3 blocks.

Materials listed below are for (3) blocks.

<b>Fabric:</b> Background	(3) 6½ x 6½"
<b>Camel Embroidery Leather:</b> Reindeer	(3) 4 x 3½"
<b>Kimberbell® Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Fusible Backing</b>	
 • Iron to the <b>wrong side</b> of the Background Fabric.	



### Embroidery File

**4x4-july**

**4x4:** 3.22 x 3.26" or 81.8 x 82.8 mm



## Embroidery Thread Colors

<b>D</b> Medium Brown 20464	<b>E</b> Coffee Bean 27518	<b>A</b> White 10000*
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This project was made with Glide thread from Hab+Dash® by Fil-Tec®.

\*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

## Quilting Options

### Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

• Hoop the stabilizer only.

#### Design

**A** kdq667-christmas-17, 4x4 design  
4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm

#### Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



### Option 2: Traditional Quilting

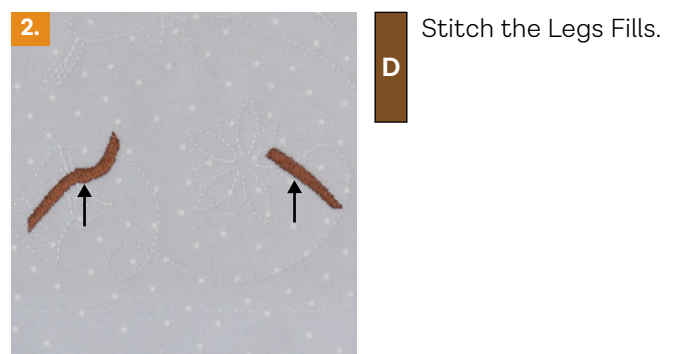
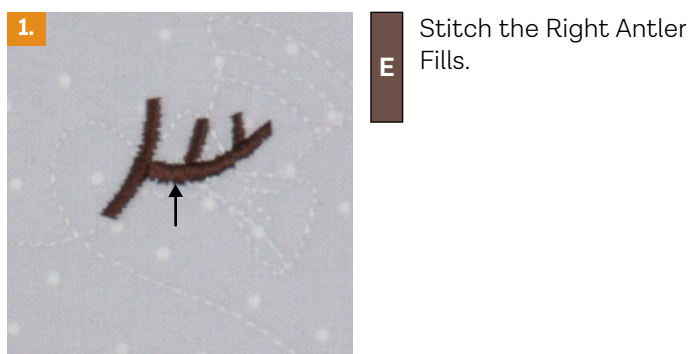
(Refer to the **Guide**.)

#### Traditional Hooping:

- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

**Note:** The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Use these instructions for both hooping options.

## Embroidery Instructions



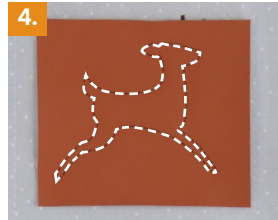

**D** Stitch the Reindeer Placement Line.

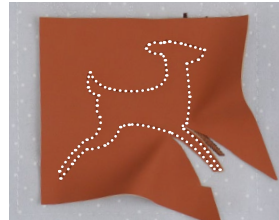


• Place the Reindeer Leather, **right side up**.

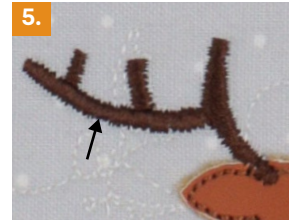

**D** Stitch the Reindeer Tack-down Line.

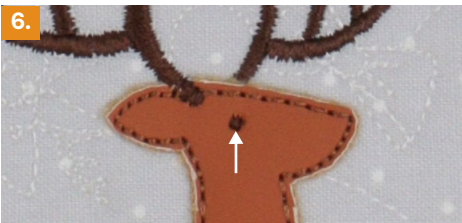


• Trim the leather as desired. This is a raw-edge applique.



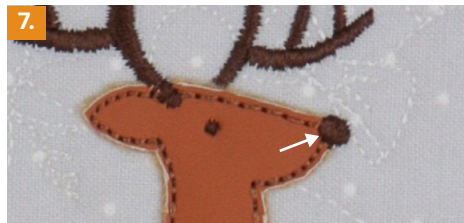

**E** Stitch the Left Antler Fills.

**E** Stitch the Eye Fill.

**E** Stitch the Nose Fill.



• Remove the block from the hoop. Repeat these instructions to make a total of **(3)** blocks.

### Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the **Guide**.)

- Place a 4½ x 4½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to 4½ x 4½".

**Note:** The Twine will be added later, in the last month of the project.




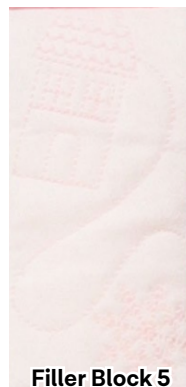
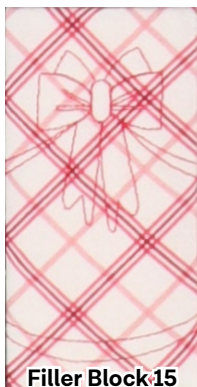
# Filler Block Instructions

## Optional Block-by-Block Quilting

### Filler Blocks 5, 15, and 24

Make 1 of each filler block.

<b>Fabric 1:</b> Filler Block 5	(1) 3 x 5"
<b>Fabric 2:</b> Filler Block 15 Filler Block 24	(1) 3 x 5" (1) 5 x 3"
<b>Kimberbell® Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Project Batting</b>	
<b>Fusible Backing</b>	
 • Iron to the <b>wrong side</b> of <b>all</b> fabric pieces.	



### Embroidery Thread Colors

<b>K</b> Blush 70698	<b>M</b> Valentine 71795
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### Quilting Instructions

For more information on quilting the filler blocks, refer to the “Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)” section in the **Guide**. Use the following quilting designs.

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
<b>K</b> Block 5	kdq666-winter-10, 2x4 design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm
<b>M</b> Block 15	kdq668-bows-2, 2x4 horizontal design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm
<b>M</b> Block 24	kdq668-bows-2, 2x4 vertical design	2.50 x 4.50" or 63.5 x 114.3 mm

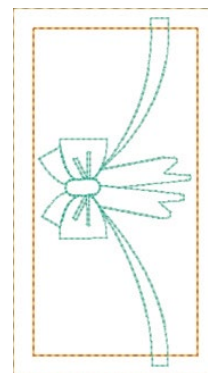

**After** quilting, trim each quilted filler block to the Standard Size listed below.

Filler Block	Trim to Standard Size
Block 5	2½ x 4½"
Block 15	2½ x 4½"
Block 24	4½ x 2½"
