JUNE BLOCK


Block Instructions

June Block

Make 2 pieced blocks.

Materials listed below are for (2) blocks. June Block 1 is a different colorway than June Block 2.

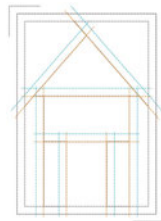
Fabric 1: June Block 1, Piece 1 June Block 2, Piece 2 June Block 2, Piece 3 June Block 2, Piece 4	(1) 2½ x 3" (1) 2 x 3" (1) 2 x 3" (1) 2½ x 4"
Fabric 2: June Block 1, Piece 2 June Block 1, Piece 3 June Block 1, Piece 4 June Block 2, Piece 7	(1) 2 x 3" (1) 2 x 3" (1) 2½ x 4" (1) 3½ x 4½"
Fabric 3: June Block 1, Piece 5 June Block 1, Piece 6 June Block 1, Piece 8 June Block 1, Piece 9 June Block 2, Piece 5 June Block 2, Piece 6 June Block 2, Piece 8 June Block 2, Piece 9	(1) 2 x 4½" (1) 2 x 4½" (1) 3 x 5" (1) 3 x 5" (1) 2 x 4½" (1) 2 x 4½" (1) 3 x 5" (1) 3 x 5"
Fabric 4: June Block 1, Piece 7 June Block 2, Piece 1	(1) 3½ x 4½" (1) 2½ x 3"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Fusible Backing	
 • Iron to the wrong side of all of the Fabric 3 and Fabric 4 pieces.	

 **Note:** Use a mini iron or finger press along the seam lines. If you are using an iron, remove the hoop from the machine and press on an ironing board.

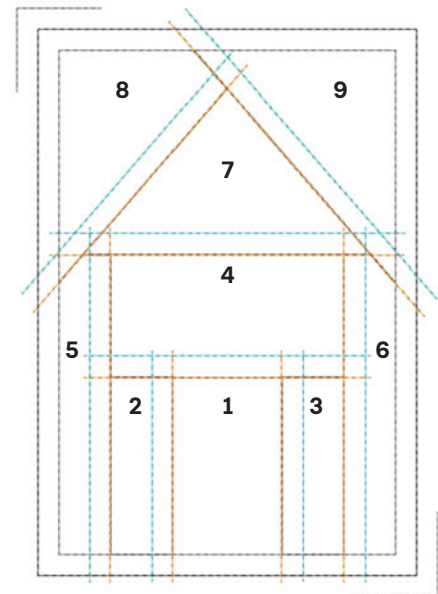

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

• Hoop the stabilizer only.

Design

A kdq666-winter-10, 4x6 design
4.50 x 6.50" or 114.3 x 165.1 mm

Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Pieced Blocks" section in the [Guide](#).
- After placing the batting and trimming, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



Option 2: Traditional Quilting

Hooing Instructions:

- Cut the stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Hoop the stabilizer only.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

• Flip the fabric **right side up**. Press well.



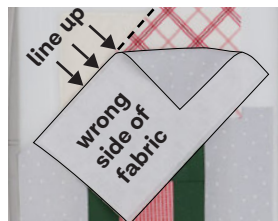
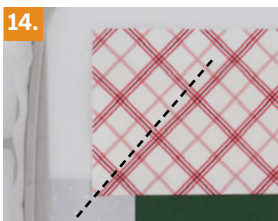

• Flip the fabric **right side up**. Press well.



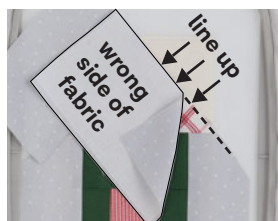
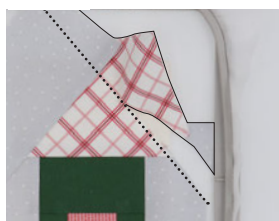
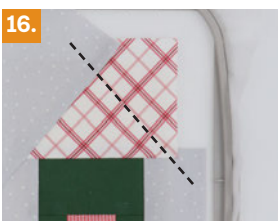

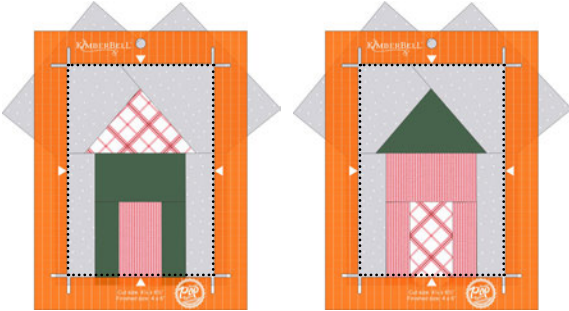
If doing the optional block-by-block quilting, stitch the quilting design on top.

Trimming Instructions

(Refer to the **Guide**.)

• Place a 4½ x 6½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.

⚠ • Using the trimming line as a guide, visually center the design and square the block to 4½ x 6½".

Note: The Wreath Buttons will be added later, in the last month of the project.
