MARCH BLOCK

Block Instructions

March Block

Make 2 blocks.

Materials listed below are for (2) blocks.

Fabric 1: Background	(2) 6½ x 8½"
Fabric 2: Candle	(2) 3½ x 5"
Pink Jelly Vinyl: Dripping Wax	(2) 3½ x 3"
Gold Mylar: Flame	(2) 2 x 2"
Pine Green Embroidery Felt: Leaves	(2) 4½ x 3"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer*	
Fusible Backing	
 • Iron to the wrong side of all fabric pieces.	

*Additional stabilizers are listed below.

*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

Quilting Options

Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away** stabilizer only.

Design

kdq666-winter-10, 4x6 design
4.50 x 6.50" or 114.3 x 165.1 mm

Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



Option 2: Traditional Quilting

(Refer to the **Guide**.)

Traditional Hooping:

- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away** stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.


Note: The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method.

Use these instructions for both hooping options.


Embroidery Instructions



F Stitch the Flame Placement Line.




• Place the Flame Mylar, **right side up**. Tape in place.



F Stitch the Flame Tack-down Line and Decorative Fill.



• Remove the tape. Tear away the excess Mylar.



G Stitch the Inner Flame Fill.



C Stitch the Wick Fill. **K** Stitch the Candle Placement Line.

• Place the Candle Fabric, **right side up**.

K Stitch the Candle Tack-down Line.

• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.




K Stitch the Stripes Fills. **M** Stitch the Candle Satin Outlines.

K Stitch the Dripping Wax Placement Line.

• Place the Dripping Wax Jelly Vinyl.

K Stitch the Dripping Wax Tack-down Line.




• Trim the jelly vinyl close to the stitch line.

K Stitch the Dripping Wax Decorative Outline.

J Stitch the Leaves Placement Lines.

• Place the Leaves Felt.

J Stitch the Leaves Tack-down Lines.



• Trim the felt as desired. This is a raw-edge applique.

F Stitch the Veins Details.

• Remove the block from the hoop. Repeat these instructions to make a total of **(2)** blocks.

Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the **Guide**.)

- Place a $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ " Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Note: The White Beads will be added later, in the last month of the project.

Filler Block Instructions

Optional Block-by-Block Quilting

Filler Blocks 17, 19, and 20

Make 1 of each filler block.

Fabric 1: Filler Block 17	(1) 5 x 5"
Fabric 2: Filler Block 19	(1) 5 x 5"
Fabric 3: Filler Block 20	(1) 5 x 5"
Kimberbell® Stabilizer	
Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer	
Project Batting	
Fusible Backing	
• Iron to the wrong side of all fabric pieces.

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Quilting Instructions

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
L	Block 17 kdq666-winter-10, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm
K	Block 19 kdq667-christmas-17, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm
L	Block 20 kdq666-winter-10, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm

After quilting, trim each quilted filler block to the Standard Size listed below.

Filler Block	Trim to Standard Size
Block 17	4½ x 4½"
Block 19	4½ x 4½"
Block 20	4½ x 4½"
