# Block Instructions

## March Block

Make 2 blocks.

Materials listed below are for (2) blocks.

<b>Fabric 1:</b> Background	(2) 6½ x 8½"
<b>Fabric 2:</b> Candle	(2) 3½ x 5"
<b>Pink Jelly Vinyl:</b> Dripping Wax	(2) 3½ x 3"
<b>Gold Mylar:</b> Flame	(2) 2 x 2"
<b>Pine Green Embroidery Felt:</b> Leaves	(2) 4½ x 3"
<b>Kimberbell® Stabilizer*</b>	
<b>Fusible Backing</b> • Iron to the <b>wrong side</b> of all fabric pieces.	

\*Additional stabilizers are listed below.

\*Needed only for optional block-by-block quilting.

### Quilting Options

#### Option 1: Block-by-Block Quilting

- Hoop the **Light Mesh Cut-Away** stabilizer only.

##### Design

**A** kdq666-winter-10, 4x6 design  
4.50 x 6.50" or 114.3 x 165.1 mm

##### Centered Alignment:

- Center the block file with the quilting file.
- Refer to the "Quilting on Applique/Threadwork Blocks (or Technique 1)" section in the **Guide**.
- After quilting, go to the Embroidery Instructions.



#### Option 2: Traditional Quilting

(Refer to the **Guide**.)

##### Traditional Hooping:

- Mark the **center** of the Background Fabric.
- Cut the **Medium Cut-Away** stabilizer larger than the embroidery hoop.
- Tape the fabric to the **center** of the stabilizer.
- Hoop the stabilizer and fabric with the **center** mark in the **center** of the hoop.
- Load the embroidery file into the machine.
- Go to the Embroidery Instructions.

**Note:** The photos in these instructions feature the Block-by-Block Quilting Method. Use these instructions for both hooping options.

### Embroidery Instructions

**1.**

**F**

Stitch the Flame Placement Line.

• Place the Flame Mylar, **right side up**. Tape in place.

**2.**

**F**

Stitch the Flame Tack-down Line and Decorative Fill.

• Remove the tape. Tear away the excess Mylar.

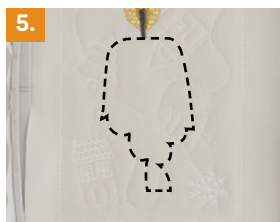
Stitch the Inner Flame Fill.

Stitch the Wick Fill.

Stitch the Candle Placement Line.



right side of fabric

• Place the Candle Fabric, **right side up**.

Stitch the Candle Tack-down Line.



• Trim the fabric close to the stitch line.

Stitch the Stripes Fills.

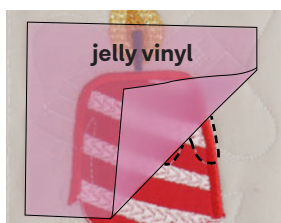
Stitch the Candle Satin Outlines.

Stitch the Dripping Wax Placement Line.

• Place the Dripping Wax Jelly Vinyl.



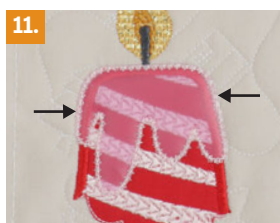

Stitch the Dripping Wax Tack-down Line.



• Trim the jelly vinyl close to the stitch line.

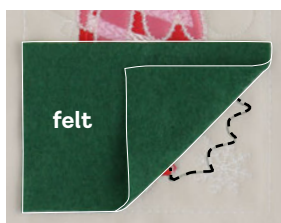
Stitch the Dripping Wax Decorative Outline.

Stitch the Leaves Placement Lines.

• Place the Leaves Felt.



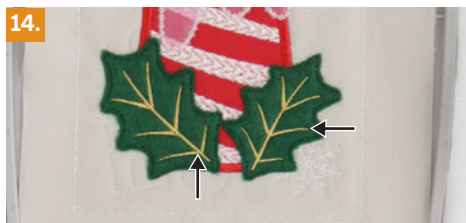

Stitch the Leaves Tack-down Lines.



• Trim the felt as desired. This is a raw-edge applique.

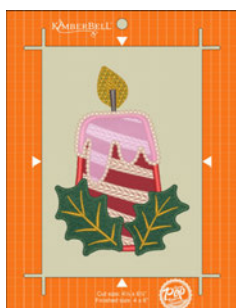
Stitch the Veins Details.



• Remove the block from the hoop. Repeat these instructions to make a total of **(2)** blocks.



## Trimming Instructions



(Refer to the **Guide**.)

- Place a 4½ x 6½" Orange Pop Ruler over the block.
- Visually center the design and square the block to 4½ x 6½".

**Note:** The White Beads will be added later, in the last month of the project.

# Filler Block Instructions

## Optional Block-by-Block Quilting

### Filler Blocks 17, 19, and 20

Make 1 of each filler block.

<b>Fabric 1:</b> Filler Block 17	(1) 5 x 5"
<b>Fabric 2:</b> Filler Block 19	(1) 5 x 5"
<b>Fabric 3:</b> Filler Block 20	(1) 5 x 5"
<b>Kimberbell® Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Light Mesh Cut-Away Stabilizer</b>	
<b>Project Batting</b>	
<b>Fusible Backing</b>	
• Iron to the <b>wrong side</b> of <b>all</b> fabric pieces.

Filler Block	Quilting Design	Embroidery Field
<b>L</b> Block 17	kdq666-winter-10, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm
<b>K</b> Block 19	kdq667-christmas-17, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm
<b>L</b> Block 20	kdq666-winter-10, 4x4 design	4.50 x 4.50" or 114.3 x 114.3 mm

Filler Block	Trim to Standard Size
Block 17	4½ x 4½"
Block 19	4½ x 4½"
